The Basic High School Men's golf team captured for the first time the Nevada AAA golf championship held at Black Mountain Golf course on Friday.

Russell Sloan of Basic led the Wolves to victory by being first in the individual standings with an even-par 72.

The Wolves had a total of 396 strokes, beating by four strokes Western High School and Reno High School that were tied for second place.

Wolves' Darryl Potter finished with 77 to place sixth and Tom Smith had an 80 to place 14th.

According to Police, Mrs. Elliott said she heard noises

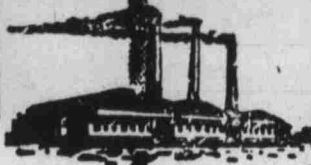
and they seemed to come from the cooler vents. When debris starting dropping out of the vents she called police.

Public Hearings Set By Planners

Public hearings on four different matters will be held at the city planning commission Wed. at 8 p.m. in the city planning commission chambers, according to Bob Gordon, planning director.

The public hearings will be held on an application from Terry D. Smith, 1301 Palm St., for a use permit to repair motorcycles at his home; from Richard Gross, 1700 E. Desert Inn Road, for a zone change from R-1 to R-3 of approximately 29 acres in section 5; on a request from Walter L. Gardner, president of the Bingo Barn, Inc., for a use permit to conduct gaming at 1545 No. Boulder Highway; and on a request from Vera Love, president of Kathwend, for a zone change from R-R to TE-H of approximately 20 acres in section 33.

Architectural review of a bingo barn to be located at 1545 No. Boulder Highway, will be discussed by the Planners.

Tentative map review will be made of three subdivisions, Lewis Homes of Henderson in Section 27; City View Terrace in section 24, and Casa Linda, Unit No. 10, in section 17.

A discussion on a planned unit development for condominium in section 5, will be held, along with a discussion on division of state lands training sessions June 12.

Architectural review will be made of a request from Robert Swadell for review of car wash sign at 151 Sunset Road.

'OLD VEGAS' PLANS MID-SUMMER OPENING

Construction of Phase I of Old Vegas, a family oriented theme park to be located on the Boulder Highway near Henderson, is proceeding rapidly toward a mid-summer completion.

The \$2.5 million western park recreating the colorful history of Southern Nevada is being built by Old West Corp. Old West Corp., is the parent company of Old Tucson, the famous Arizona tourist attraction and movie locale.

Old Vegas is also being designed to accommodate movie and television productions. Plans call for a 12,000 square foot motion picture sound stage at the Henderson park. The western streets of Old Vegas were laid out by a noted Hollywood artist and great care is being taken to insure the historical authenticity of Las Vegas as it began and as it grew.

Work is now nearing completion on the "Mormon Fort", which will dominate Old Vegas from the highway. Visitors will enter by crossing over a wooden plank bridge which spans the waters of "Las Vegas Stream".

The fort will house a historical museum, sutlers store, rip-roaring "Hondo Casino" and other glimpses of life in the old west.

A big grand opening celebration is planned for Old Vegas this summer. Plans will be released soon outlining events and dates for the opening.

Within a few days, movers will transport building from the original El Rancho Vegas Hotel to the Old Vegas site. The El Rancho buildings will be incorporated as a part of the restoration of Las Vegas as it looked many years ago. In addition, an antique railroad car will be delivered and installed on the site. The car will be used as offices for Old Vegas personnel.

Old Vegas was designed by Robert Shelton, president of Old West Corp., and master planned by LARC of Dallas, Tex. Principal architects for the development are Wells, Tate and Kennedy of Las Vegas.

Police Need Help in Missing Equipment

Henderson police are asking assistance of anyone who might have seen a large piece of road equipment being loaded up between noon on May 13 or through 7 a.m. May 15.

According to police the road equipment was located on West Victory and Van Wagenen and is valued at \$14,445. Police said it would have to have been loaded onto a truck and hauled away.

It was described as a 1977 yellow Case Tractor with blue wheels, a front loader and a back scraper. It is owned by Blythstone Equip and was being used by Las Vegas Paving for road work on Victory Road.

'Have to be Unified' Chamber Members Told

"We're all a community together ... and we have to be unified," Tim Carlson, Director of the Nevada Development Authority told members of the Chamber of Commerce at their monthly meeting last week.

Carlson has just recently been appointed director of the organization which he said "has been around for a number of years."

"It is about 23 years old but

your community, you're going to have to tell them. You're going to have to help sell your community."

Several large corporations are looking at the Southern Nevada area for possible locations, Carlson said, and they will be going around the community talking with the people.

He said that corporation officials who have visited Southern Nevada have come to realize that the area is more than the image most of the country has of Las Vegas. It is made up of nice homes in the communities, churches, schools, more than just a gambling and entertainment center.

Carlson told the membership that NDA is made up of a Board of Directors, each member with a specific job to do, should prospective businesses show an interest in locating development in this area.

Their financing is derived from donations from the membership and others and they received this past year \$20,000 from the county, \$14,000 from the City of Las Vegas and \$54,000 from the state. They expect to get about a 30 per cent total increase from their revenue sources for next year's budget.

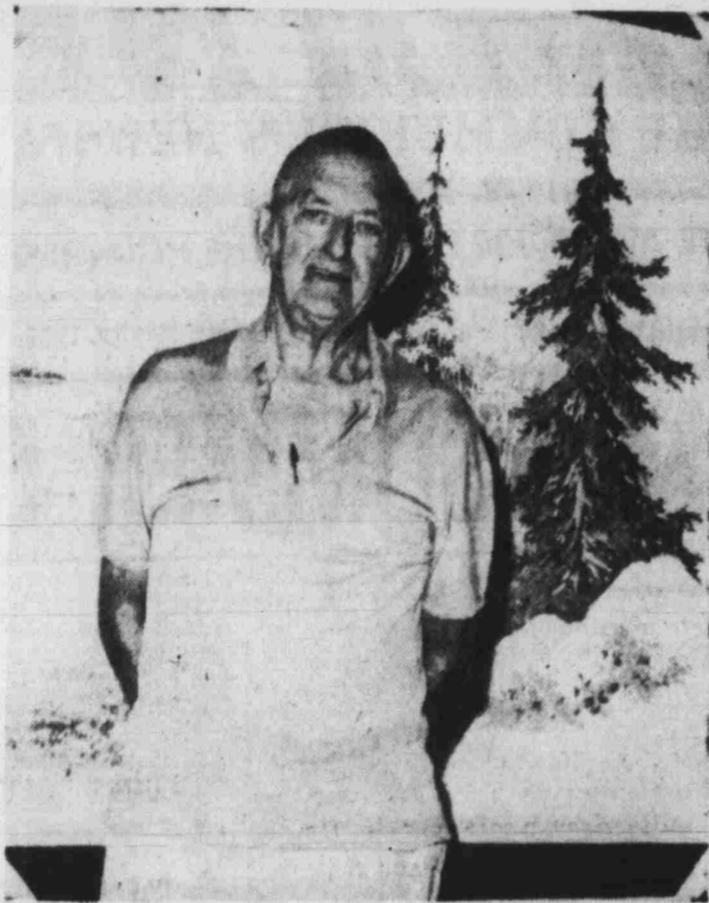
Starting with a survey crew in 1946, Robison worked all over the state, then was elevated to resident engineer 10 years later with another 12 years spent in statewide service.

Rainbow Club Features Free Dixieland Jazz Concert

The Royal Dixie Jazz Band will be appearing at the Rainbow Club Theatre in downtown Henderson on Friday, May 19 at 8 p.m. The concert is free to the public on a first come, first serve basis.

Dixieland jazz, that magical music - spawned in the street bands of New Orleans in the late 1800's, weaned in the brawling south side of Chicago during the cold winter of 1916 and destined to mature as the first native American music style, is on the move again.

Now, it's Bourbon Street, Las Vegas, with the banners of the hot jump being borne by an aggregation of the finest Dixieland talent available today.

The "Royal Dixie Jazz Band" is the culmination of the lifetime dream of player-leader Charles "Chuck" Diamond, violinist, trombonist and graduate of the Cleveland Conservatory of Music, who turned down a job with the St. Louis Symphony to organize a Dixieland jazz band. That was several years and many bands ago.

In 1973 Diamond's break came in an extended gig at Michael Gaughan's Royal Inn Casino in Las Vegas. Diamond's band began to take shape with a solid rhythm section.

In addition to Chuck Diamond, the band features the following great talent.

Henry "Hot Lips" Levine, whose driving

trumpet carries the melody line, at age 15 replaced Nick LaRocca with the world famous "Original Dixieland Jazz Band." He originated the highly rated NBC radio show, "The Chamber Music Society of Lower Basin Street," and is considered the finest Dixieland trumpet in the country, if not the world.

George Mosse, clarinetist, plays flawless counterpoint on the treble notes. His take off on breaks and solos is always in traditional Dixieland style. Mosse is a music major graduate of Southern Methodist University. It was during his college years that he first became interested in Dixieland music. His love of the traditions of Dixieland fits him to Levine's trumpet like a hand in a glove, and some of the best solo work is by Mosse.

James Fitzgerald, trombonist, cut his musical teeth on Dixieland music in the basement of his Mason City, Iowa home. Fitzgerald's father, a Dixieland player, knew the music from its inception and began teaching his son trombone at age 7 when the youngster had to use his foot to play the bottom of the slide. His first Dixieland band was organized at age 12 and two years later the group was playing dates. Fitzgerald's ensemble work is outstanding and he plays in the traditional "gut bucket" style of the original Dixieland groups.

Joe Mayer, banjoist,

orphaned at nine, began playing banjo on street corners for pennies. He grew up with Dixieland music in speakeasies and barrooms and for many years led the top ranked vaudeville and television act, "The Novelities." Mayer's banjo and vocal work is the frosting on the cake for this band.

George "Fingers" Pollak, pianist, plays with the free - swinging style of the best ragtime piano players and his work on "The Old Piano Roll Blues" is a bare taste of his keyboard abilities. Pollak, one of the most in demand pianists in Las Vegas, has backed some of the top entertainers that have appeared on the Strip. His preference, however, is at the "88" with the Royal Dixie Jazz Band.

Lou Lalli, drummer, is the heartbeat of the band. Lalli was one of Diamond's first choices in selecting his rhythm section. - Dixieland drumming, more than with any other style, requires playing as well as maintaining a strong beat. In each of these areas Lalli proves his mastery of the instrument, maintaining a strong backbone beat for each song, then adding that extra Dixieland flavor which can only be described as melody.

So, for a relaxing evening of good ole Dixieland jazz, come on over to the Rainbow Club this Friday evenings.

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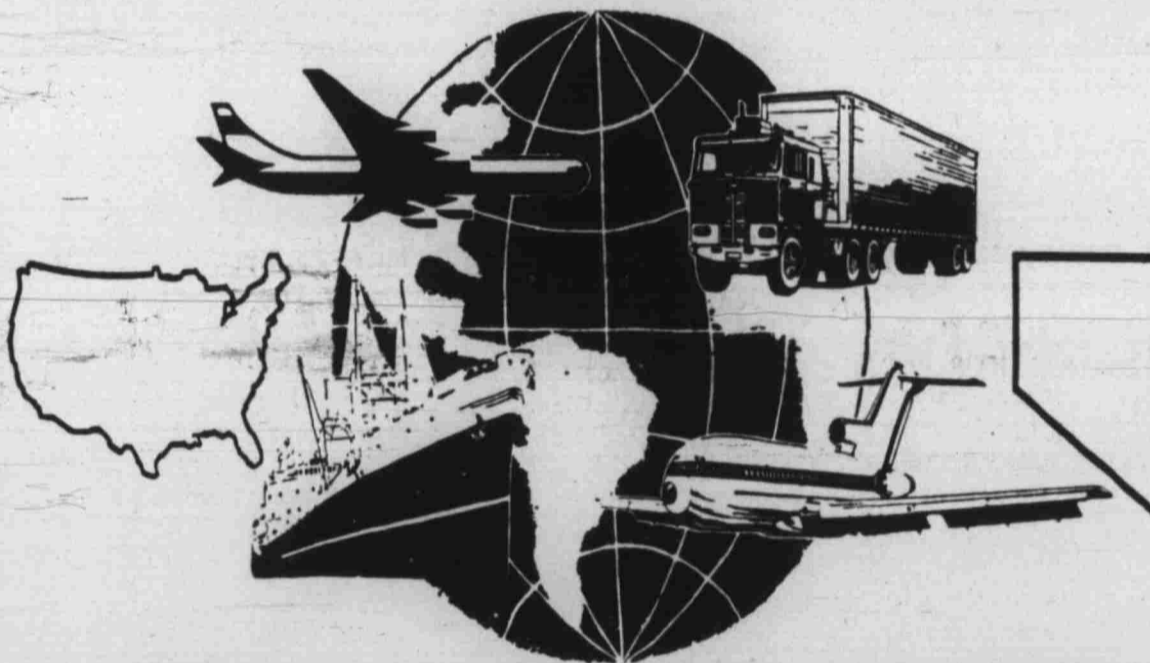

News from Boulder City Denzil S. Pease Receives Paul Harris Fellowship

There is no higher honor in the association of Rotary clubs throughout the world than that of receiving the Paul Harris Fellowship Award. In the Boulder City Rotary Club only one man has ever received this esteemed honor and that is Denzil "Denny" Pease of 925 New Mexico Street. The story of the Paul Harris Foundation is explained in another part of the NEWS today. The material was contained in an address by a California Rotarian named Herbert Hezlep. Denny Pease it listed

in a world famous book called "Leading men in the United States." This honor was accorded him for many reasons, one being the work he did on setting up the Clark County uniform electric code. He is listed there as belonging to the Elks, the American Institute Electrical Inspectors, Director of the Federal Credit Union, Director, Southern Nevada Electric League.

Long before Boulder City had a paid director of recreation there were volunteers working on

three ballfields to benefit our youth and also the adults who loved sports of every kind. In this story there are hundreds of volunteers, not only that but Boulder City had a football field so highly rated that none other in the state was built to where State track meets could be held with the single exception of Reno. Bruce Eaton tells this story. L.R. Douglass was Director of Power on the Hoover Dam Project, his "boys" as he called Denny Pease, Bruce and 101 other volunteers, were given the encouragement and loan of government equipment to build the best football field, softball field and hardball field in the state! The men worked entirely on a volunteer basis. Denny, as did the others would give up their lunch hours, and go directly to the field after work.

At a recent Rotary meeting, L.R. Douglass was presented with a moment called "This is Your Life" with Elton Garrett reciting the facts he had gathered. When finished, E.G. looked about at his fellow Rotarians and asked, "Did I leave something out." Up rose Bruce Eaton with the reminder of how L.R. Douglass had guided the men who volunteered from the Government to build the football field at the B.C.H.S. Denny Pease was one of those volunteers.

Denny Pease As A Community Volunteer

He served for 10 years as a member of the Board of Directors in the Boulder Dam Federal Credit Union. From 1965 thru 1969 he was President. As President of the BDFCU he served during the construction of the modern facility that now houses the growing and dynamic organization.

From 1943 to 1966, Denny was an active member of the B.C. Recreation Association. He not only helped pour concrete at the BCHS field, he also had complete charge of the layout, engineering and in-

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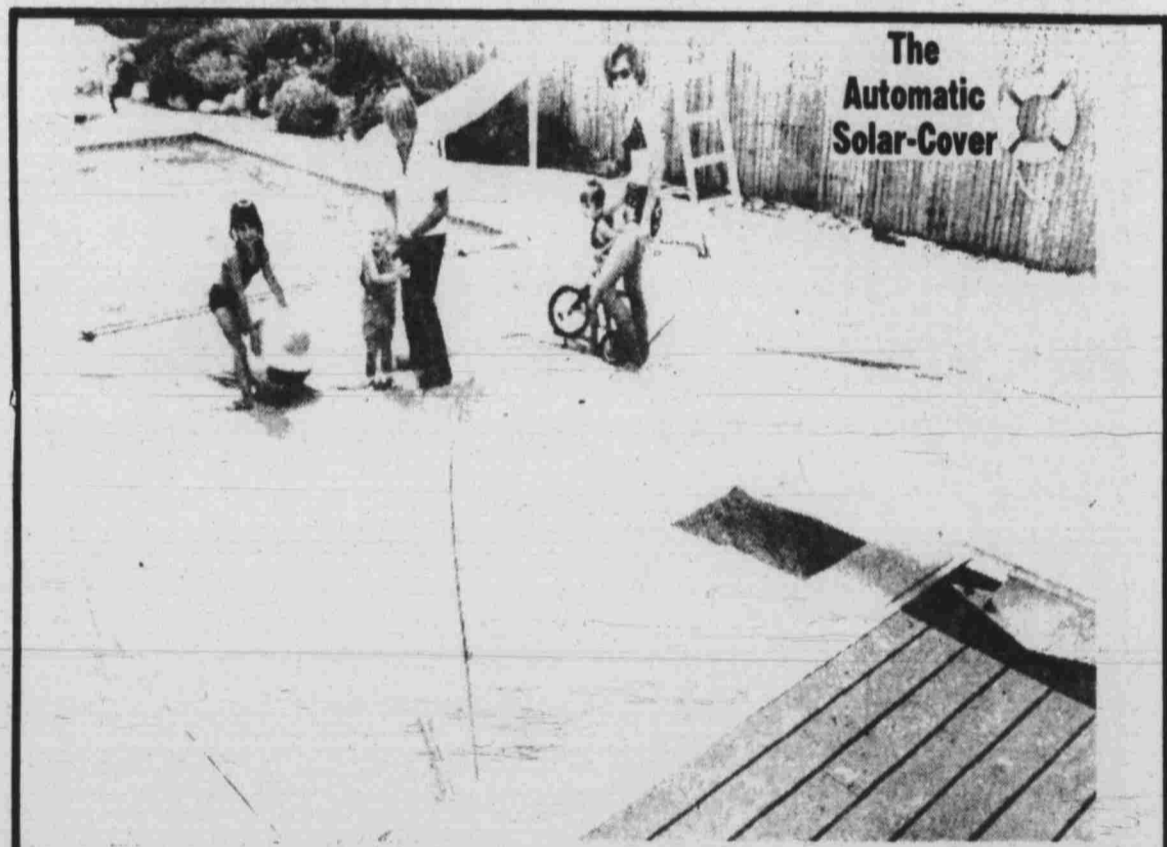

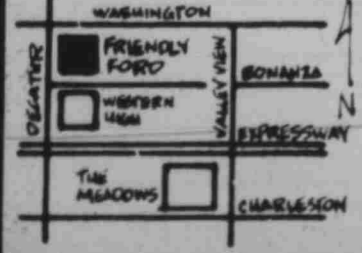
