Remember last week in this column we mentioned that various of our top state officials went to Washington to push for a \$24 million Federal allocation to build a leg of U.S. Highway 395 that goes thru Reno?

Well, let's take a close look at the Associated Press report of the invasion of Washington headed by our governor, Mike O'Callaghan.

Freeway To Be Completed

RENO (AP) - If the federal government releases funds in the near future for the completion of U.S. Highway 395 through here, the long awaited freeway could be completed by the summer of 1980, Nevada Highway Engineer Joe Souza said Friday.

Souza, who attended a meeting of state and federal officials Thursday in Washington, said he was encouraged by the administration's promise to place top priority on the \$25 million project. Funds for the project, which Federal Highway Administrator Karl Bowers said are likely to be authorized soon, will allow a 2.8 mile stretch of freeway south of Interstate 80 to be finished in two years.

Bowers told Souza and other Nevada officials that no project has a better claim to federal highway funds than 395. State highway officials and politicians have contended for some time that completion of the route is critical to alleviate serious traffic congestion.

Looks like they got something on, doesn't it?

And there's nary a word in the report that refers to the Henderson Vegas - Boulder freeway, or any part of the project that would extend from the Vegas freeway system to Desert Inn road, in its first stage, and then on out to R.R. Pass, as the second stage.

Yet this freeway of ours won top priority from the state highway department, the federal highway system and from Mike himself a year or so ago.

Since then our Boulder highway has become more crowded, more screwed up with traffic lights, city, county and state fly copy, and 35 mile per hour signs every few minutes. ... all because of the same growth pattern they're talking about in their arguments up north.

So -- what are we going to do about it?

The governor got back from Washington in time to attend the Jim Santini roast that accompanied Jim's announcement he's a candidate to stay in the congress.

It was held in the beautiful Hilton ballroom and it was well decorated, staged to copy any national political convention. Balloons, straw hats, colorful short - dressed girls parading up and down the aisles, carrying banners and signs, accompanied by sound effects taken from actual conventions. It was very effective.

Until the speeches -- the so - called roasts. They were pre - written for the speakers and they were filled with gutter humor, latrine wise - cracks, sickening remarks from men who carry state and national offices.

Bob Shelton Explains Future of 'Old Vegas'

The first 100 years of Las Vegas...complete with the influence of the railroad, gambling and the infamous Block 16...Speakeasies and a rip - snorting old western street...all this and more will be recreated in the Old Vegas soon to open on Boulder Highway in Henderson according to Robert Shelton.

Speaking to approximately 100 persons at the B.C. Chamber of Commerce Annual Installation Banquet at Bob Vorchota's Railroad Pass Casino Friday, Shelton described with great enthusiasm the concept and plans for the project.

Well seasoned in this type of enterprise ...he brought Old Tucson from obscurity to national fame...Shelton told of his fascination with the early history of the Las Vegas area. "With all the glamour in Las Vegas...the glitter, the lights...I felt there should be more. Here's an area where so much happened...so much historical significance...the romance and excitement of the old west happened right here. The first 100 years captivated us...and it's this

period we're attempting to recreate as authentically as possible".

The Old Vegas project is designed to "stimulate fantasies" and transport visitors back in time.

Development is being done in two phases. The first phase should be completed this summer. It will include a replica of the Mormon Fort (with some adaptations), with stores, a cantina and a 300 seat theatre inside. The theatre will show a special movie on the history of the Las Vegas area currently being produced under Shelton's direction.

Outside, visitors may inspect an old railroad car...an authentic steam train and a swaying stage-coach.

The second phase will produce Block 16, a complete main street of a Western town...with an inviting road leading out to a group of miner's diggings and a deserted mining town. Further on, there'll be a railroad museum.

The complex will be constructed to meet the requirements of film production and Shelton expects both movie and TV shows to be "on location" at Old Vegas once completed. Several production companies have already expressed a desire to film here.

Local Telephone Customers May Get Refund On Bills

Henderson customers of Continental Telephone Co. will be among those in several locations expected to receive a refund for increased rates charged since March, 1977, however, officials in the local office of the telephone company say they have not been notified of the Supreme Court's recent ruling.

The expect it will be about a week before information is received here.

The Nevada Supreme Court decision means that the telephone company will have to refund most of the \$800,000 in increased rates it collected from customers since March 1977.

The court modified a district court decision arising from a suit by Continental,

which serves telephone customers in Douglas and Lyon Counties and Henderson.

Continental filed an application in 1974 with the Public Service Commission for permission to raise rates \$1.5 million. The State agency allowed an increase of only \$233,966. Continental then filed suit.

The Supreme Court in 1977, allowed the company to charge about \$600,000 in higher rates while the legal appeal was processed. The company had to post a bond to pay a customer refund if it lost.

The Supreme Court, in its decision, sided with the Public Service Commission on one major point in disallowing \$531,461 in the rate.

New City Fire Station Delayed

A delay in the building of the portable fire station for the city and delivery on the chassis of two mini fire pumps may delay the opening of the new fire station located near the Henderson Boys' Club, according to City Manager Bob Campbell.

The city had planned to open the new fire station on

July 1, however, Campbell said Aug. 1 may be a "more realistic date."

Campbell said the truck manufacturer is having problems getting delivery on the chassis that is needed, and the contractor putting up the station is behind as well.

Campbell said the city still hoped to beat the Aug. 1 date.

Russell Sloan Qualifies for Junior World Golf Tournament

While back a friend invited Russell Sloan to play golf. Five years and about 30 trophies later, he is still playing golf, nearly every day, and hopes to eventually "maybe be a pro".

"Russell dove right in with both feet," said his mother, Linda Sloan. "When he isn't playing on the golf course, he is working at Black Mountain Golf and Country Club or practicing in the yard...or in the house," she said laughingly as she pointed to a few minor credit nicks on the livingroom wallboards.

Russell gives a great deal of credit for his success to Robert Taylor, former principal of the elementary school which was named for him upon his retirement several years ago.

"He gave me so much encouragement and has helped so many other boys who have shown an interest in golf," Russell explained.

One of Russell's most unusual trophies was won at a tournament in which he played at Death Valley. And again, Mr. Taylor was instrumental in Russells being in that particular tournament as that is just another of the kindnesses shown by the former educator... taking kids so they might participate in tournaments outside the Las Vegas area.

These past few days Russell has been in Reno participating in still another tournament. He qualified on the county level in the Southern Nevada Insurance Classic and this

Some of his more treasured ones include Most Improved and the Most Valuable, which he received following the Men's Nevada AAA Golf Championship at which Basic High School took first place in the state.

But his most treasured are the medals he recieved from the State Meet...first in individual standings with an even-par 72.

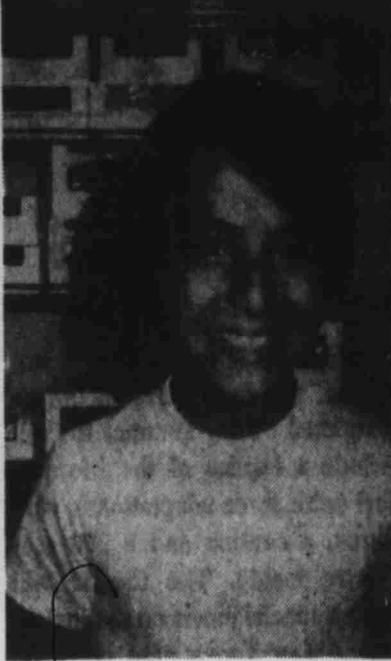
TODAY'S QUESTION: If you could be the United States honorary President for one month with full support of Congress, what would you do?

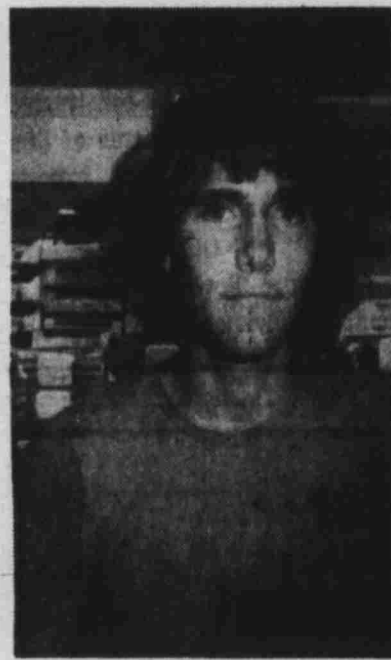

Jean, throughout her life, has not only dedicated her efforts to the home but is one of the concerned people who have donated time and talent to causes, issues, politics, and religion.

Jean has served as a Sunday School Teacher for thirty years. She formerly taught at Skyline Wesleyan in San Diego and more recently served in the First Southern Baptist of Henderson. Among her credits are serving as Sunday School Director of the Henderson church; former Women's Missionary Union Director of the Lake Mead Association of Southern Baptist where she presided over four hundred women and girls, and the Women's Missionary Union Director for 1st Southern Baptist of Henderson.

A while later - Jean attended Phoenix Jr. College and spent nine months in Nurses Training at St. Mary's Hospital in Tuscon, Arizona. Later she married Fred and life was again to Jean. During her stay on the reservation, Jean was instrumental in sending a Navajo Indian girl to a Baptist Summer Camp. The girl was so overjoyed that she presented Jean with a hand-woven Navajo rug - a prized possession which to this day hangs on her living room wall and seems just like new.

Fred served for twenty years as Ordinance man for the United States Aviation and the couple spent happy years in El Cajone, California (near San Diego). During those years Jean was most active with the P.T.A. where she served as President, Vice President, Program Chairman, Inspirational Chairman and Room Mother of Fletcher Hills Elementary School. She owns an Honorary Lifetime Membership to the P.T.A.

Jean Turner is loved for she has donated herself and time lovingly to the people of Henderson. "I don't feel as well as I used to," Jean mentioned, "and I really enjoyed helping people in those better days." Jean drove hospital patients to the doctor, or on errands and shopping tours. She went so far as to aid a blind lady with home duties. Now Jean serves her fellowman with teaching Bible Classes meeting in various homes.

Hobbies are sewing, crocheting, crewel, quilting (a beautiful States quilt her newest), canning jellies, jams and venison mincemeat from some of Fred's catch.

Jean has had the pleasure of meeting Dr. Billy Graham twice. Once in San Diego and the second time when she recently represented the First Southern Baptist Church of Henderson in the Billy Graham Crusade meeting at the Las Vegas Convention Center. Naturally her favorite philosophy would be from the Bible: "Trust in the Lord with all thine heart - and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all they ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths." (Proverbs - Chapter 3 - Verses 5 and 6).

Kerr - McGee Starts Ownership Program

A new stock ownership program that lets Kerr - McGee employees become shareholders in the company at no cost to them has been started, the company announced.

The program, known as the Kerr - McGee Employee Stock Ownership Plan, has been established under provisions of the U.S. Tax Reduction Act of 1975, which allows companies to receive a 1 percent in-

vestment tax credit if the credit is used to purchase stock for employees through an organized plan.

All non - union employees with at least three years of service are immediately eligible to participate in the stock ownership plan. Employees represented by a union agreement and who have been employed by Kerr - McGee for at least three years will be eligible to par-

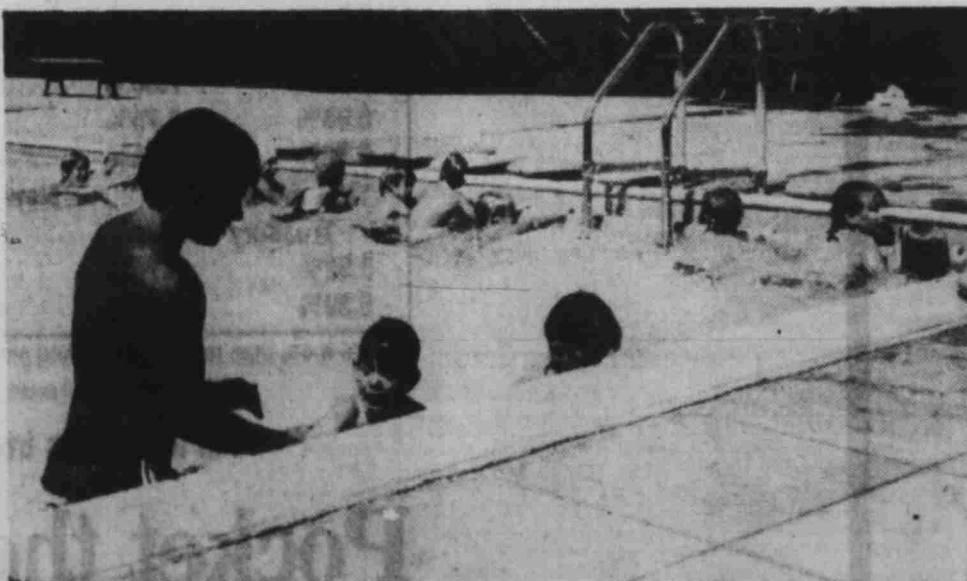
ticipate in the plan when it becomes a part of their agreement, Dave Zilar, savings investment supervisor, said.

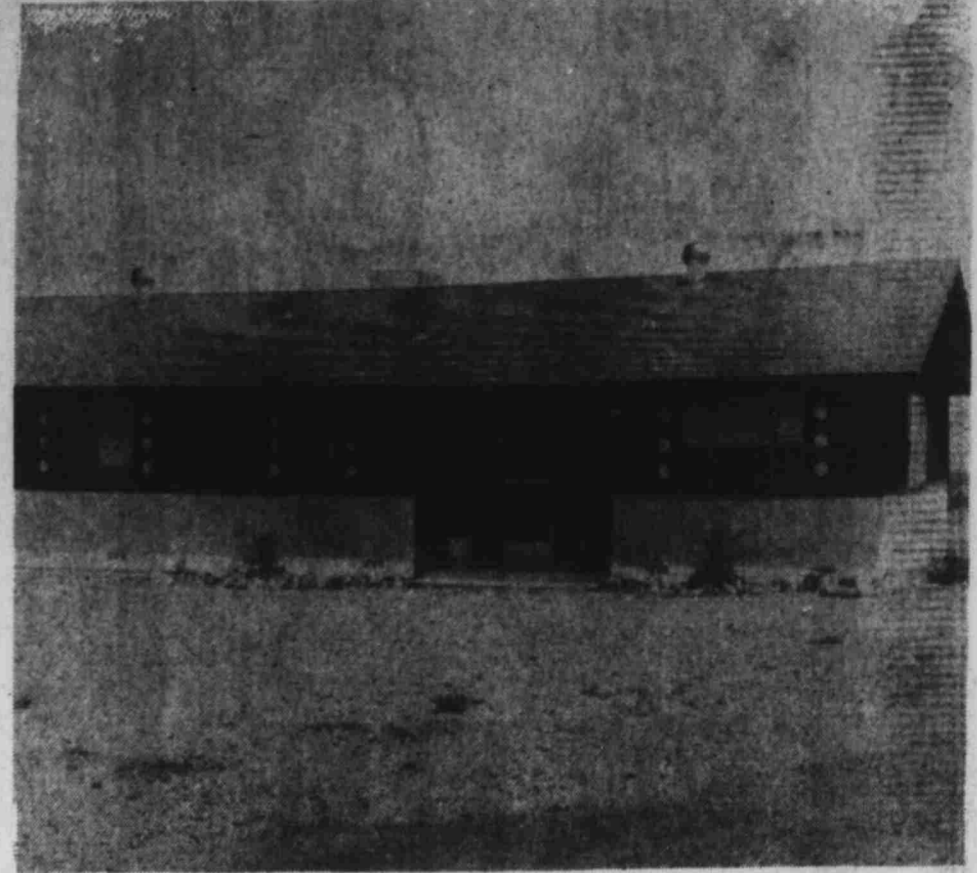
