
What do you do when you pay a parking ticket in cash and two years later they send you an upgraded bill for it saying you never paid for it?

Sugarman Sells Interest In Westworld

Johnny Mitchell, co - founder of Mitchell Energy and Development Company of Houston, Texas, and the major stockholder in Westworld, Inc., has purchased the interest of Burt Sugarman in Westworld, Inc., it was announced today.

Sugarman bought substantial interest in Westworld. Inc., on March 12, 1979, and became chairman of the board, president, and chief executive officer shortly thereafter. A voting trust agreement with Mitchell gave Sugarman and his associates voting control of more than 50% of the outstanding stock of Old Tucson Corporation, the then parent corporation. The voting trust agreement has been terminated.

On May 14, 1979, the name of the parent corporation was officially changed to Westworld, Inc., and the policies and marketing direction were changed. The name of the corporation's Nevada project had previously been changed. The name of the coporation's Nevada project had previously been changed to Westworld Park on March 14, 1979. Mitchell indicated that plans are being made to form a new energy company which will become a wholly owned oil producing subsidiary of Westworld, Inc.

Westworld, Inc., (WEST), whose stock has been trading on the NASDAQ system, is a Delaware corporation and is the parent for three wholly owned subsidiaries: Old Tucson Corp., an Arizona corporation which operates the famous movie location and western theme park near Tuc-

son, Arizona; Old West Corp. dba Westworld, a Nevada coporation operating Westowrld Park on Boulder Highway between Las Vegas and Hoover Dam; and Mescal Corp., an Arizona corporation which operates a western street for moviemaking near Benson, Arizona.

With Sugarman's departure, structural changes in the Board of Directors were revealed. Robert Shelton and David Gotterer remain as board members. Shelton was designated president and chief executive officer of Westworld, In. Also appointed to the board were Ellison Miles as chairman of the board, Cecil Simmons, and Mitchell.

Shelton has served as

The first phase of the Henderson Community College, approved by the 1979 Nevada State Legislature at \$1.9 million, was discussed by the citizens' advisory board, who were advised that groundbreaking ceremonies could take place in the spring.

The new college will be built on 80 acres of land provided by the City of Henderson in the vicinity of Horizon Drive and Mosswood.

Taking part in the discussion were University Regent James L. 'Bucky' Buchanan, Dr. Judith Eaton, president of the Community College, Dr. Paul Keider, dean of instruction; Cliff Mitchell, in charge of the physical plant, and Leo F. Borns, architect, and Assemblyman Jack Jeffrey.

Others who are on the advisory board include Edie Barker, Southern Nevada Children's Home; Selma Bartlett, manager, Bank of Nev.; Wayne Bennett, Chief of Police in Boulder City; Bob Broadbent, Clark County Commissioner: Bob Campbell, city manager; Artie Cannon, manager, Shady Rest Motel; Caesar Caviglia, director, Growth Opportunities, Inc.; Don Dawson, coordinator, Henderson Industrial Trades.

Joe Crowley, Eldorado Club; Low LaPorta, La Porta Insurance Agency; Lanny Lund, principal, Basic high school; Frank Brusa, principal of Vo-Tech.; Joe Phillips, principal, John S. Park School; Phil Roybal, TIMET; Lorna Kesterson, Henderson Home News.

Betty Scott, coordinator for the Community College, will be named director of the Henderson campus, which will consist of 22,000 square feet of building for the first phase.

The college now has 1803 students as compared to 162 in

The development of the Henderson campus began in 1972 when adult classes in Spanish and English were offered in Henderson by Growth Opportunities. Growth opportunities was a local-non-profit organization composed of civic and religious leaders. St. Peter's Church provided the classroom space, and the Clark County Community College offered credit to those who completed the courses. These classes were taught by Betty Scott.

By Jan., 1975, a group of prominent local citizens were discussing the community's need for an expanding college curriculum with the administration of the Clark County Community College.

As a result of their efforts, the course offerings in the spring semester were expanded to include Math 101, History 217, and psychology 101 in addition to the previously offered Spanish, English and Southwest Heritage programs. With only one week advance publicity, 98 people enrolled for the new courses. This was considered an enthusiastic response from the community.

During the next four years, more classes were offered and the student enrollment continued to increase. During the 1978-79 academic year, the number of classes offered in Henderson had increased to 103 and 1803 students were enrolled. This obvious response of the citizens in Henderson and the surrounding area to the opportunities for educational development offered by a community college was a major factor in acquiring a permanent community college campus in Henderson.





BASIC'S VISIT TO CLARK NOT PLEASANT

Being the visiting team for the dedication of a new stadium can be an unpleasant experience.

Just ask the Basic Wolves, following their 20-0 loss Friday night to the Clark Chargers in the inaugural game on the turf at Collis Stadium, named for long - time coach and administrator Angelo Collis.

For the Wolves, the frustrating evening was another example of how things can go wrong despite playing some pretty good football. For instance, running back Darryl Turner scored a 55-yard touchdown on a pass from quarterback Jeff Buckel, only to see it called back when Basic was whistled for an illegal receiver downfield.

Although most statistical categories in the game were close to even, the difference proved to

be the Clark rushing game, which piled up 176 yards. Steve George accounted for 120 yards of that total. Meanwhile, the Wolves could manage only 64 yards on the ground.

Through the air, Buckel connected on just two of six passes for a minus one yard, while Clark's Tony Shaw completed only one of four passes for 17 yards. Shaw's poor perfor-

mance passing marked the second straight game in which the Wolves shut down the aerial game of a highly - rated quarterback. Last week they hounded Gorman's Danny Tarkanian into a and put him out of the game with a broken

After an initial exchange of possessions, the Chargers jumped to a 7-0 lead on an eight-vard run by Shaw and the kick by Kevin Armendariz. However, a stingy Basic defense kept the Clark offense in check the remainder of the first half.

But Clark broke loose for two touchdowns in sub - par performance , the third period on a three - yard run by George and an 11-yard

dash by Carnell Smith. with Armendariz converting on the final tally for the 20-0 count.

The Basic ground game, which had problems all night, found Turner gaining just 28 yards and Eric Mangrum adding another 15.



Carrying proper equipment is essential for a safe, enjoyable backpacking experience. Daniels says. "You must have quality equipment, because you'll bedepending on it for survival in the wilderness," he explains.

• Find a shop that specializes in backpacking equipment and has a trained staff to give advice and answer questions. Talk to more experienced campers to learn what kinds of equipment has worked best for them.

 Buying the best equipment you can afford usually pays off in the long run. High-quality gear performs better and lasts longer.

· Choose a backpack that is lightweight and fits your body frame, yet provides the necessary room for gear. Fully packed, a hiker may carry as much as 35 pounds of equipment

· A synthetic fiber-filled sleeping bag resists moisture, vet "breathes" for maximum comfort. Some campers. though, prefer a down-filled bag.

· Well-crafted hiking shoes are another essential item for backpackers. Boots should fit properly and be broken in over a period of several weeks before worn on

· Once in hand. Daniels says it's important to know how to use equipment. A good way to become familiar with equipment is to test it on an overnight camping trip close to home.
