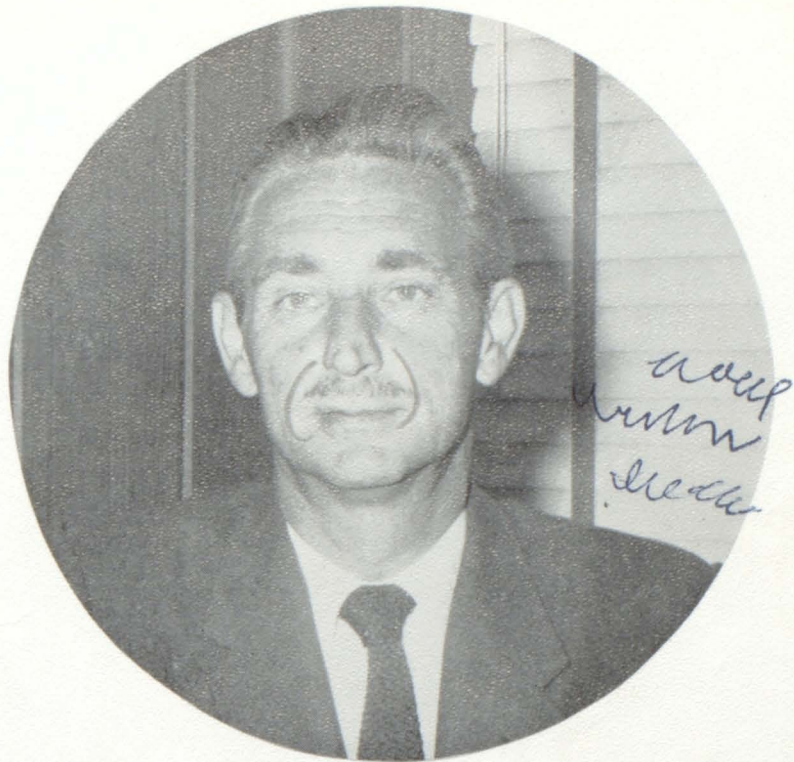
## Foreword
