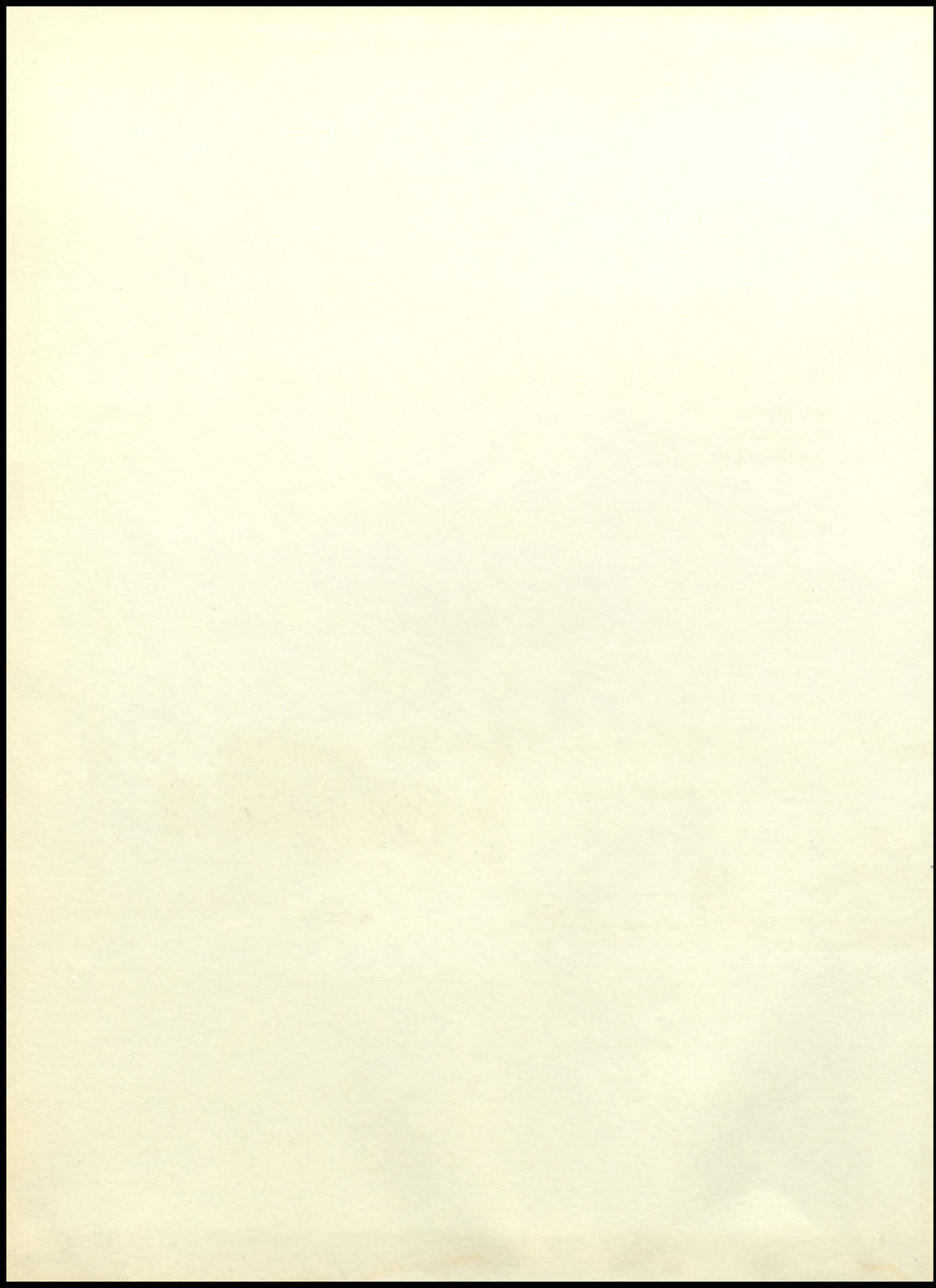

Our guide, that of past education, intellectually, socially, spiritually, emotionally, physically wears the crisp white robe of youth.


