The instructional methods and equipment that we have known so well shall be abandoned and replaced by more advanced techniques. For, as modern development progresses, so shall the education system at Basic High School.

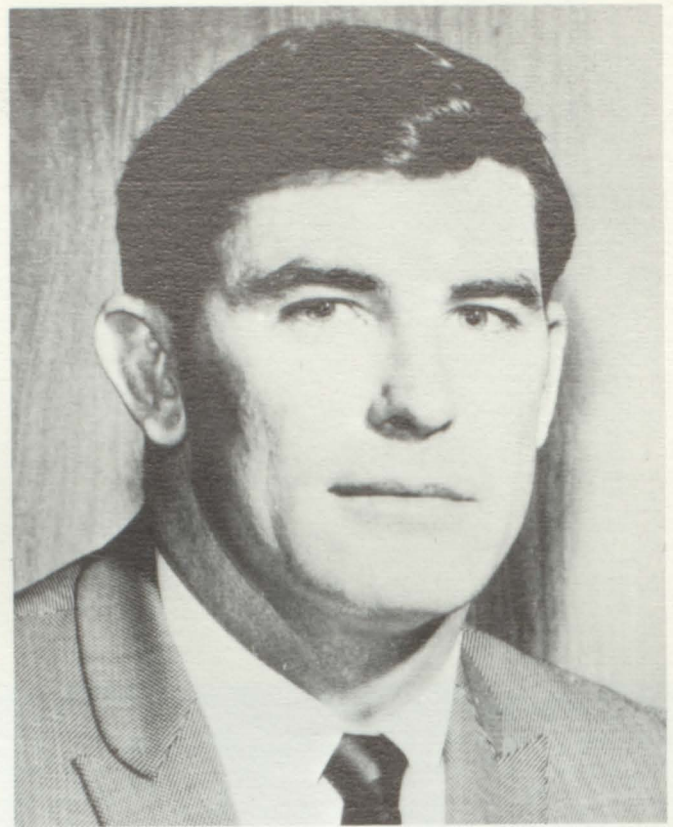




SCHOOL BOARD FORMULATES DISTRICT POLICIES

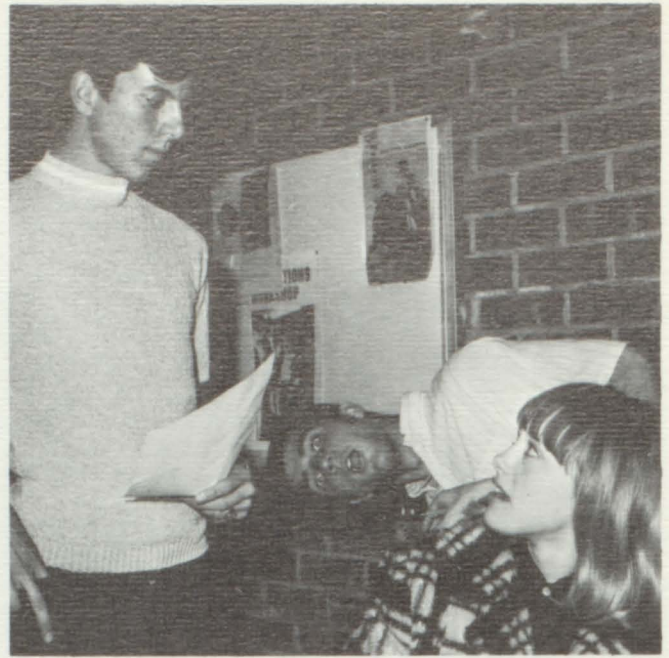

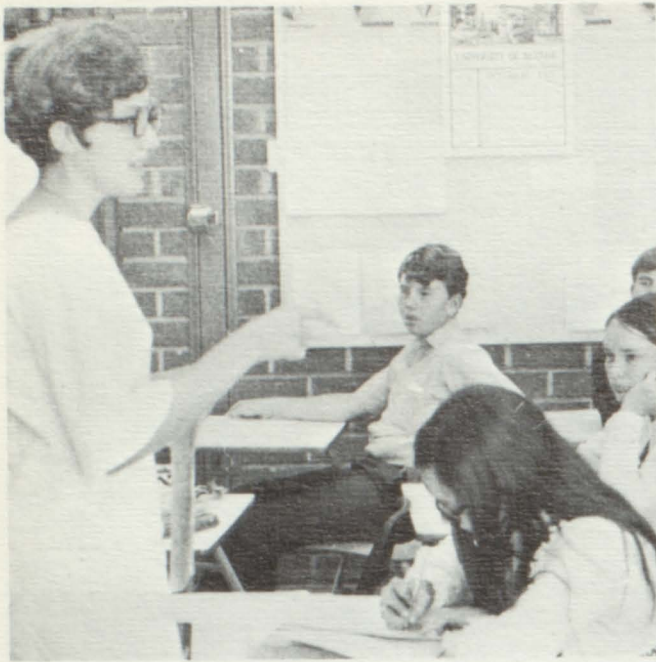
The Business Club consists of students enrolled in business classes or business courses.

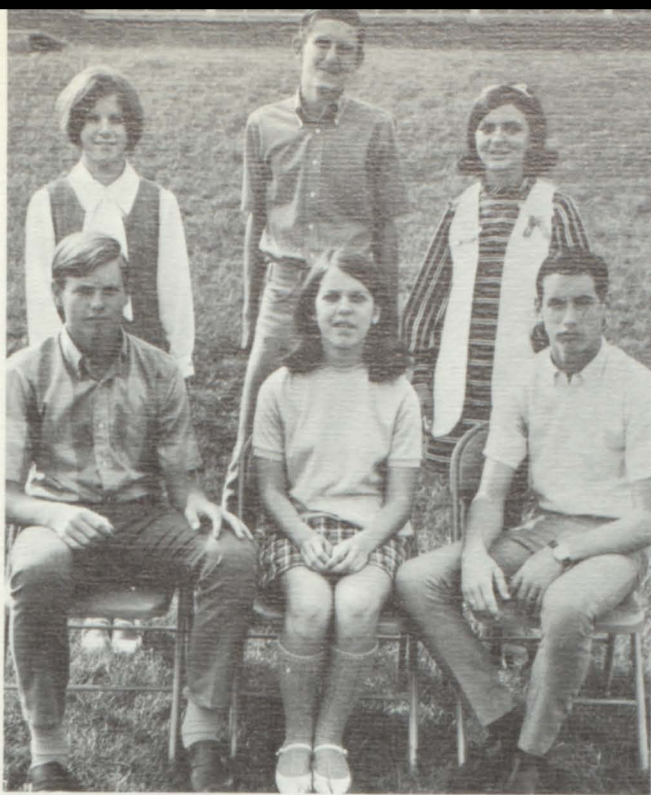

Though the club is small at the present time, we are looking toward the future when the Southern Nevada Museum will grow, as shall we.

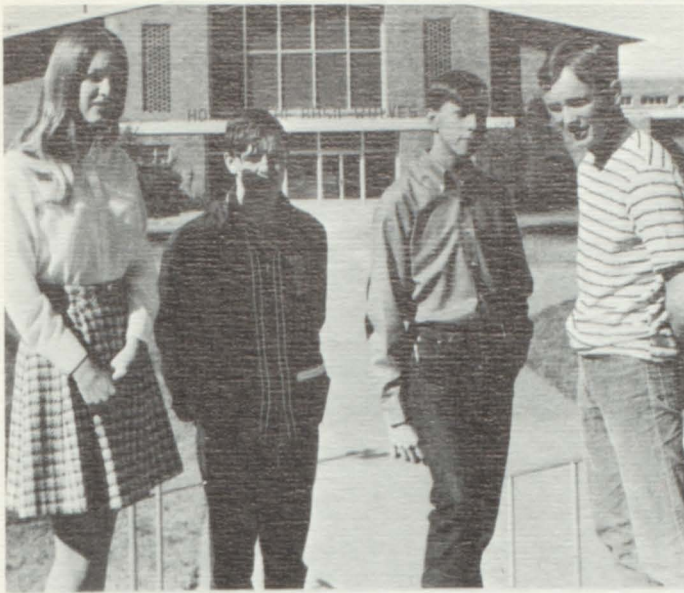

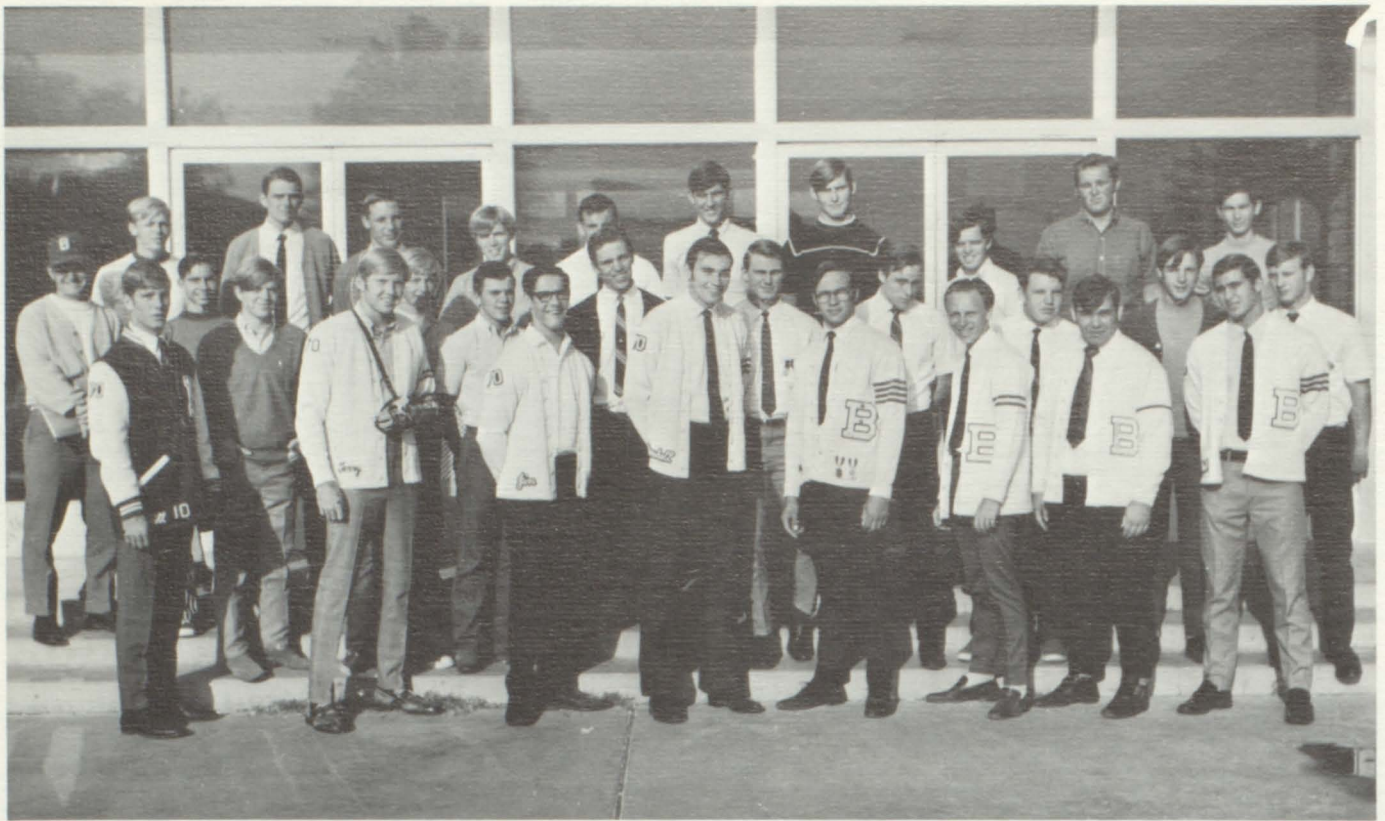
SPORTS

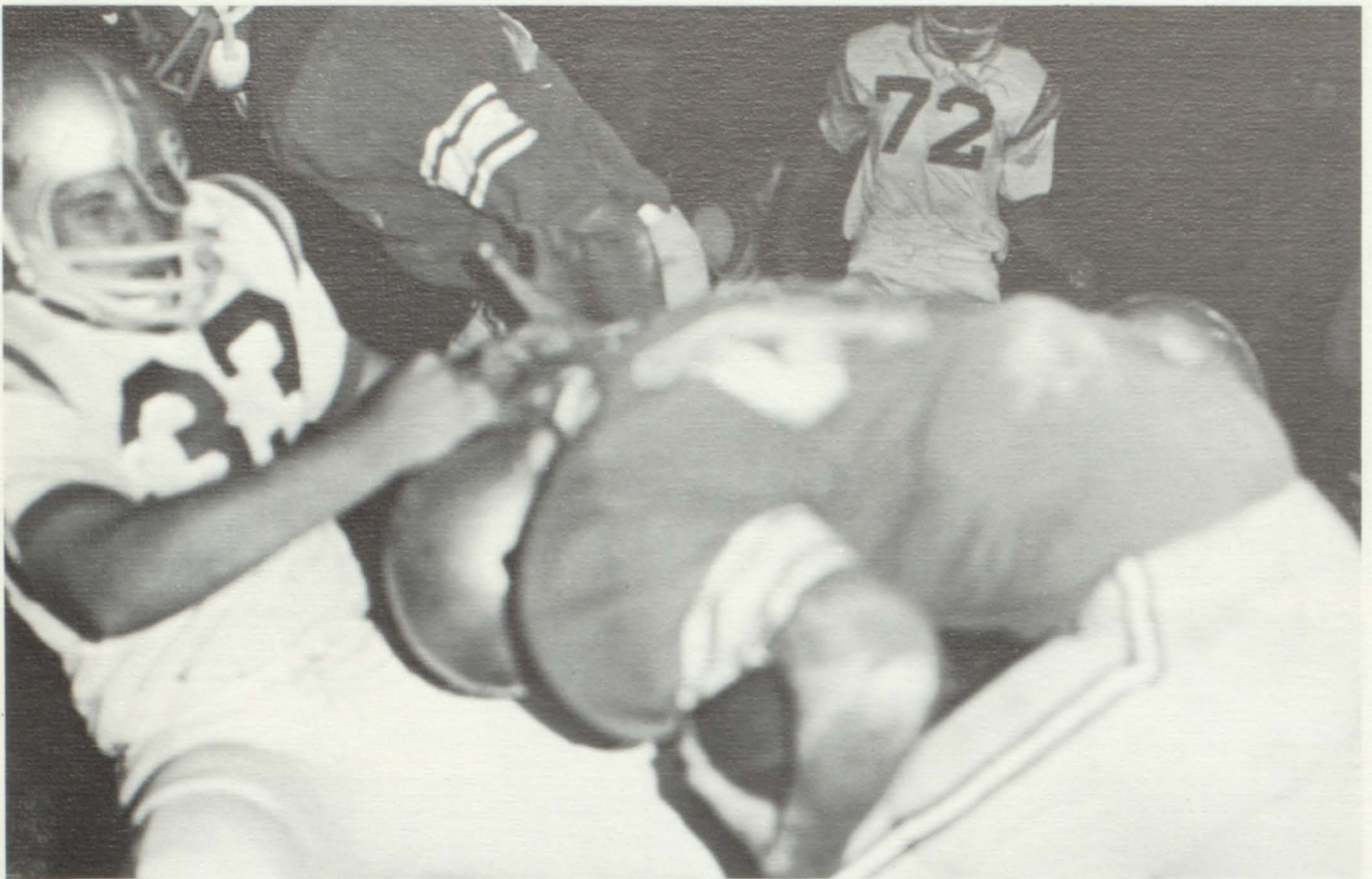
