What is a Scanning Day?

It's a free service that helps preserve your family memorabilia and grow Henderson Libraries' community-built, online Digital Collections.

This program offers the conversion of photo negatives, physical photos, and documents into digital files.



What do I need to bring?

We'll scan up to **10 photographs or documents** on site and return them to you along with a free flash drive with digital copies of your items.

If you choose to contribute any historic Henderson memorabilia to the Digital Collections, you will need to sign a Deed of Gift form allowing us to host the image online. You keep your original items!

All items you wish to contribute to the Digital Collections must be personally owned. We will not be able to accept any items that are copyrighted unless written permission is obtained from the copyright holder.

Where are my photos or documents going?

Donations from the Scanning Day will be included in the Henderson Libraries Digital Collections, an online, freely accessible collection built from community organizations and member donations. There are over 12,000 items available to view including photographs, newspapers, and even yearbooks from Henderson's beginnings in the 1940s.
