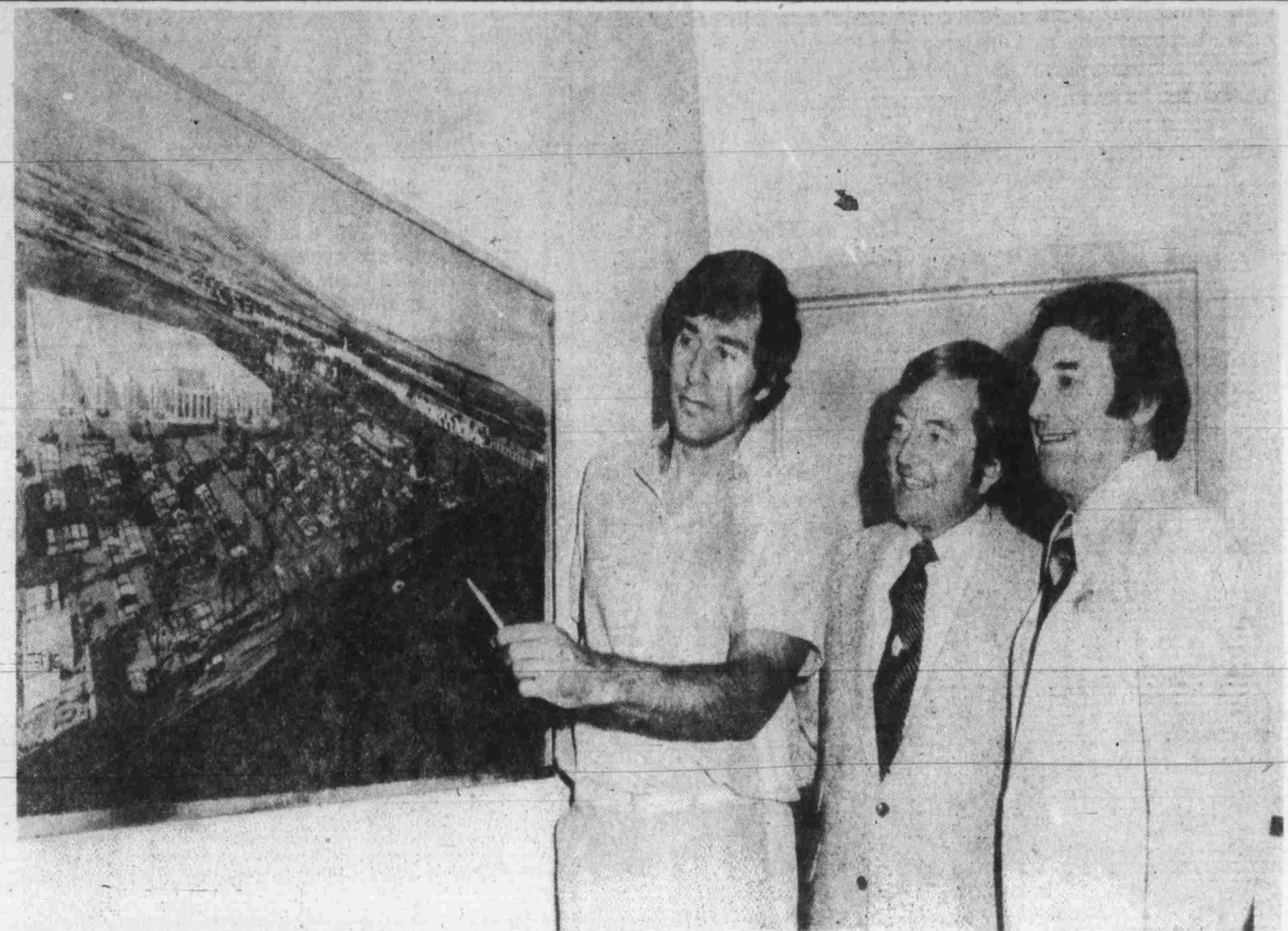

Dallas Firm Joins Westworld Management

Burt Sugarman, chairman of the board of Westworld, Inc. today announced that Leisure and Recreation Concepts Inc., Dallas, Texas, has become affiliated with the management of the theme parks which the company operates near here and in Tucson, Arizona.

Sugarman said that Michael A. Jenkins, president of LARC has reached an agreement in principle to assist in the management and operations functions of the Westworld Park at Henderson and Old Tucson, near Tucson.

J. R. Minick, a vice president for operations for LARC has been named general manager of Westworld and John R. Brown, director of marketing of LARC has been named general manager of Old Tucson.

Jenkins, who founded LARC in 1970, is a graduate of Southern Methodist University with degrees in theater and business management. He also studied architecture under Roy Holbein, a staff instructor for the late Frank Lloyd Wright.

He began his career in the amusement park industry in 1961 at Six Flags Over Texas and as a vice president for special projects, Jenkins played a key role in developing new Six Flags parks.

As president and founder of LARC, Jenkins has been the primary designer and-or feasibility analyst of a number of parks in the United States, Canada, Germany, Australia and Africa.

Among these were Apapa Park,

Lagos, Nigeria; Paradise Center, Gold Coast, Australia; and Magic Springs, Hot Springs, Arkansas. He has won two awards given by the International Association of Amusement Parks and Attractions for outstanding contributions to the amusement industry, as well as an award from the Texas Showman's Association.

Minick joined LARC in 1977 after serving as vice president of operations at Hyatt Hotels' Great Adventure amusement park in Jackson, New Jersey.

With degrees in architect-

ture from the University of Texas, and in advertising from Texas Christian University, Minick began his career in the industry at Disneyland.

He joined Six Flags Over Texas in 1961 as operations supervisor responsible for all rides and attractions. He then served in a variety of posts at other amusement parks around the country including Legend City in Phoenix and Magic Mountain in California.

He rejoined Six Flags in 1972 as director of design and

A New American Flag?

During the Flag Day ceremony held in June at the Henderson Elks Lodge No. 1956, brother Phillip C. Patrow, a member of the local lodge, exhibited a design for a new American flag which could become the next flag should Puerto Rico become the 51st State of the Union.

The new design has one large star representing the first state of the Union which was Delaware in December 1787.

Each point of the large star consists of ten small stars representing each state totaling 50, with the large star making 51.

A loan for a \$4.92 million apartment housing complex, to be located between Safeway store and Morrell Park, has been approved it was learned here.

The 40-year loan was sought by Stanford Building Group for apartment housing. The approval included using some of the apartments for low rent housing. Out of 160 apartments, 32 will be subsidized housing.

Bud Walker, (formerly of Henderson) who represents the Stanford Building Group, said the anticipated starting date for the apartments is Dec. The apartment complex will include garden apartments, swimming pool and recreation area.

The loan is from the Department of Housing and Urban Development. Jeff Lewis represents the company's home office at Palo Alto, Calif.

Services For Vi Gardner Today

Services will be held at Palm Chapel at 11 a.m. today for Viola R. Gardner, 61, who passed away August 3 in Henderson.

A resident of the area since 1948, Mrs. Gardner was born April 22, 1918 in New Bedford, Massachusetts. She was an Army veteran of World War II and a member of the American Physical Therapist Association.

She was a graduate of the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota, and received additional training at Columbia University following her graduation.

A Registered Nurse, she received her RN in Mass. before becoming a physical therapist. She also served 28 months of oversea service as a therapist and was very proud of her service record.

When Mrs. Gardner came to Nevada, she was the only certified physical therapist in Southern Nevada and the only one here for seven years.

For 26 years she worked as a PT at Southern Nevada Memorial Hospital until her retirement. However she

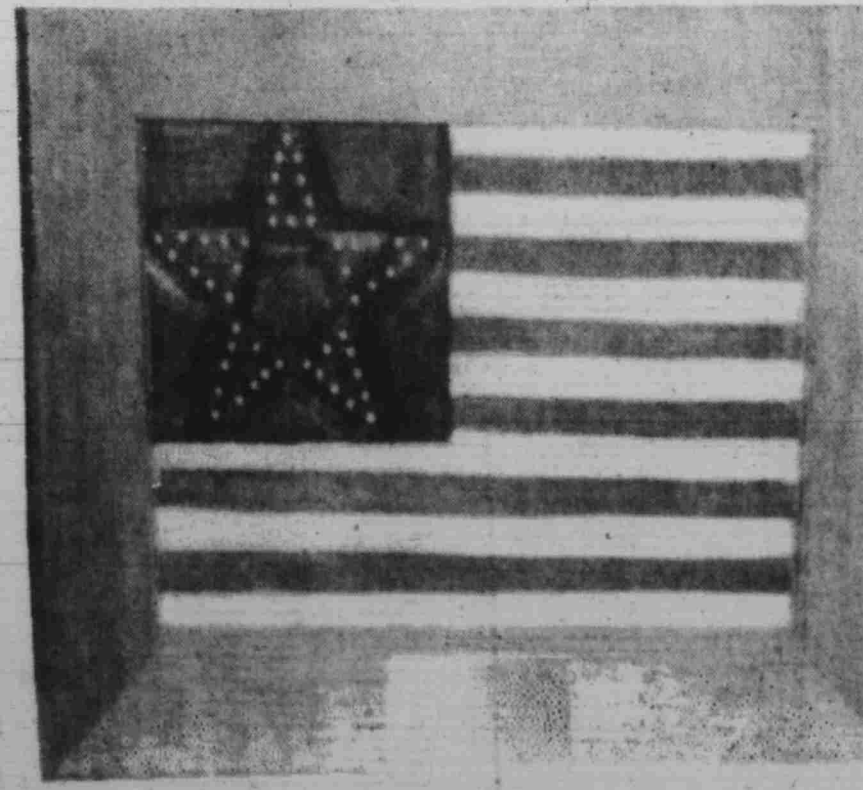

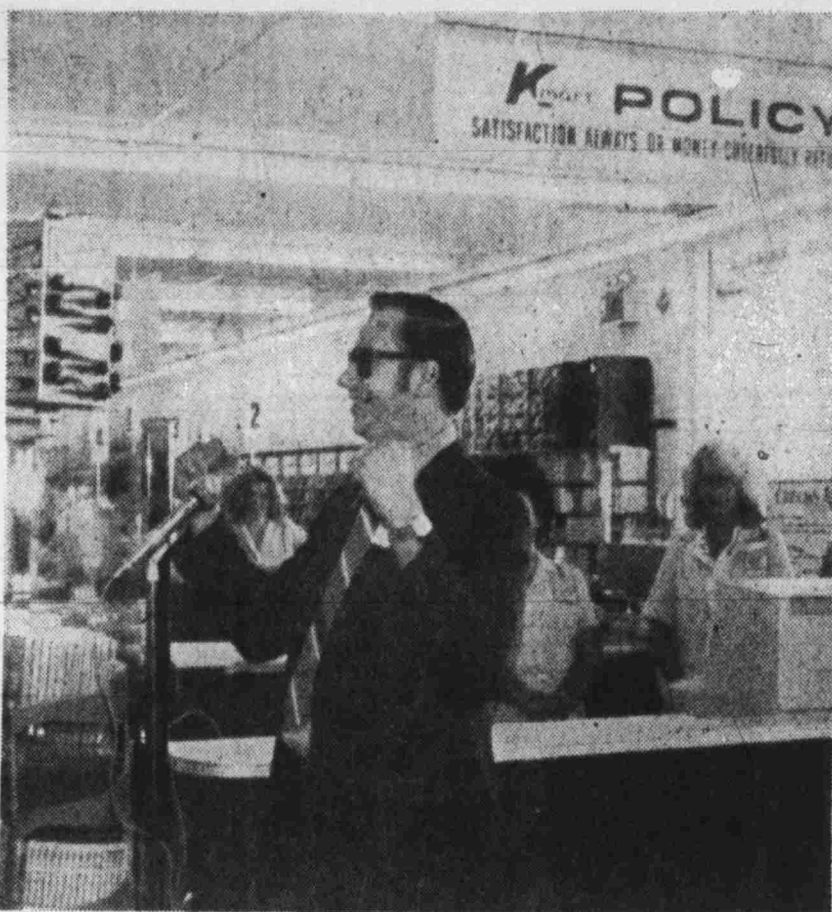
Kempner, who has been interested in the concept of a Boulder Highway Association for close to a year, said the goal of the BHTA is very simple.

City Hall Gets Solar Screens

In the new remodeling of city hall, one of the aspects has been the installation of solar screens to conserve energy and costs.

Solarex, Inc., the firm installing the screens at city hall, also installed screens at the Carriage House of Las Vegas, and various homes in the Las Vegas, Henderson, Boulder City area.

The screens reduce substantially the amount of heat transferred through windows which can save 20 to 35 per-

cent on utility costs. They also are effective in the winter season to reduce heating costs.

The Federal building in Las Vegas recently had installed solar screens and estimated a \$422,000 savings over 20 years.

BACKGROUND ON BUSINESS

Creative Enterprise

By Carl D. Newton III
Energy crunch, inflationary spiral, recession fears - each new economic pressure brings with it new questions on the vitality and validity of our system of enterprise. Just how sound is the American economic system, and what is its future?

There can be little doubt that our system has been traditionally successful, although not without serious problems and periodic re-evaluation and adjustments. Today, our system is still basically sound, but signs do point to the need for a re-evaluation of free enterprise if it is to remain sound in the future.

Business and government leaders would agree that the answers to pressures on our economy will not be found in alternative systems. The fact is that other economic systems do not provide the level of personal prosperity available in the U.S. To maintain our overall prosperity in the face of complex changes, however, it may be time to adjust our "free enterprise" system to one of "creative enterprise."

To the businessman, creative enterprise is a management philosophy that sets growth goals, recognizes a company's strength/weakness pattern, and formulates strategy to reach those goals. Inherent in that philosophy is a willingness to use traditional business tools, but only when they are useful in changing conditions. The role of creativity in creative enterprise lies in our response to change. Every new opportunity or problem must be met with a response that is innovative, and yet consistent with overall strategy. For example, Fox Photo's "Ready Tomorrow or Free" guarantee on film processing was an industry first, but this policy is also part of a larger strategic plan.



Creative enterprise, although not recognized as such, has already been expressed in some government circles. Leaders who call for a comprehensive energy plan, a strategic approach to stabilizing the import/export ratio and our currency abroad, and other measures, are actually advocating creative enterprise. They identify an objective, the need for a program to meet the objective, and understand that the program must be flexible enough to respond to changes without being substantially changed itself.

One of the oldest laws in business is that you've got to take risks. Creative enterprise can minimize those risks. Every time a new product or service is introduced, risk is involved. Every time a new product is well-conceived and introduced through a thorough plan, that risk is reduced. When that plan provides for changing conditions, product improvement, and precise management, risk is minimal. Fox Photo and other major companies benefit from creative enterprise in this way, and our system as a whole can.

Adapting to the demands of a new system is never easy, and creative enterprise is particularly demanding of its practitioners. It requires more thought and professional discipline than conventional business routine to be successful. But its rewards for business and the American system will prove well worth the extra effort in a more prosperous future for us all.

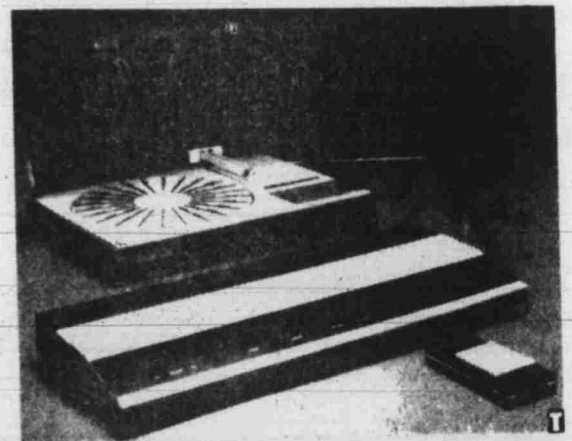
