# Relief from freeway noise on way

Henderson residents living along Interstate 515 may finally

get some peace and quiet. The National Highway System Designation Act passed the Senate-House Conference on Nov. 15, allocating \$45 million in transportation funds to Ne-

U. S. Sen. Harry Reid, who was a member of the HouseSenate conference panel, said he secured this money for Nevada to promote the revitalization of the state's highway system.

"We are the fastest growing state in the nation and these funds will help relieve some of the pressure placed on our highways," Reid said.

Reid also inserted language into the Act that requires the Federal Highway Administration, the Nevada Department of

Transportation, Clark County, and the city of Henderson to work together to create a plan to decrease the noise for residential living along Interstate 515.

"Henderson residents have been burdened by increasing noise for years, and it's about time we solve the problem," Reid

"This language is significant because it compels the FHA to solve the problem," Reid said.

"Without it, there was nothing compelling them to feel obligated. Now it is the law and they will abide by it. We in effect are ordering the FHA to come up with a plan to stop the noise,' Reid said.

When the Nevada Department of Transportation created the plans for the newest portion of I-515 in the late 1980s, they did not incorporate provisions to control the noise levels.

It is NDOT's policy to only build sound walls along existing homes aligning the freeway. At that time, there were no homes in this area.

By the time this portion of the freeway was completed, the area along its path had been fully developed.

A consultant for the city of Henderson measured noise levels above the 67 decibel level used

by the federal government in six different spots.

Once the act is approved by the President, the funds should be available in the third quarter of 1996.

Reid said the cooperating agencies must submit a plan for noise mitigation, then the funds may be approved and allocated by the panel.

# **Arroyo Grande** supper club before Council

The Henderson City Council will hear plans tonight for a commercial center across the street from the Arroyo Grande Sports Complex.

Zarcor Development would like to build a gas station/convenience store and a supper club at the corner of Windmill Parkway and Arroyo Grande Boulevard. The company is requesting a land use change, zoning and a use permit for the project.

Residents spoke in opposition to the development during a Henderson Planning Commission meeting Oct. 26. They said alcohol sales near the complex would pose a threat to those who use the park — especially children.

Planning commissioners agreed that children traveling to and from the park may be endangered by intoxicated drivers. They voted unanimously to recommend denial of Zarcor's re-

Other business before the Council includes:

·A request for a pre-school and day care center at 803 Mission Dr. in the Mission Hills area. The commission recommended denial of the project after hearing testimony from homeowners in the area. Many were opposed to the traffic and noise the center would create. The facility would be licensed for 185 children, age 9 and younger.

In a letter to the News published last Thursday, the applicants said they are going to withdraw the request. But City Clerk Susan Robison said Monday morning the issue is still on the Council's agenda.

 A recommendation to hire a consultant to address safety concerns on Water Street. The Citizens Traffic Advisory Board recommended the study due to complaints from residents about the Water Street Beautification Project. They said concerns had been raised about business access and pedestrian safety.

Sky Harbor Airport, located at 500 E. Lake Mead Dr., was founded in 1969. Current manager Eliot Alper said the airport was the dream child of his father, Arby Alper.

"My father had the vision and saw the need for another airport in the area. He acquired the land and then built this airport from scratch," Alper said.

Using their own money, the Alper family slowly acquired the structures currently located on the airport property as scrap metal, or as parts of other developments throughout the valley area.

"Every building you see here has been another structure in Las Vegas at some time. There is a lot of history here," Alper said.

# Former constable pleads no contest

Former Henderson Constable James Ebert pleaded no contest and was found guilty of two misdemeanors Friday for using false statements to collect workers' compensation benefits.

Agrand jury indicted Ebert in March 1995 on six counts of theft by misrepresentation. The indictment alleged that in 1991, Ebert submitted false compensation forms to Nevada State Industrial Insurance System (SIIS). The forms represented that he was "totally disabled" and unable to work, which meant he could receive two-thirds of his

salary from SIIS. The Attorney General's office

alleged that during the time he was getting those SIIS benefits, Ebert intentionally failed to disclose to SIIS that he was working as the Henderson constable.

All six counts referred to a period from Sept. 5 to Dec. 4, 1991, when Ebert collected money for being injured at Titanium Metals Corp.'s Henderson

# City audit OK'd

The city of Henderson will hire a consultant to examine the city's organizational structure and determine how various departments can be more efficient.

The City Council voted unanimously Nov. 7 to conduct an audit beginning with the city's development departments: planning, building and public works. The other departments of the city will be phased in as audits of the those departments staffing such as private conare completed.

A request for a management study was brought before City Council in December 1993 at Councilman Jack Clark's request. At that time, it was defeated with a 3-2 vote. Clark said the audit request has been modified, but it still addresses a

"It is important for a variety of reasons," Clark said. "I think we (the city) do a lot of things well. This will help us identify where we can do better. ... "[The study] will help us identify problem areas. We need someone who has an objective eye to tell us what things we need to change."

Councilman David Wood requested the management audit issue be re-examined by City Council. The last city management audit was conducted in 1984.

The scope of work for the study includes eight points:

· Analyze existing staff to determine if personnel are being used in the most efficient man-

 Determine present and projected personnel and statting

• Review the service the city provides to determine where

·Examine the city's organizational structure to determine maximum effectiveness.

 Develop a recommendation for phasing and funding opportunities for additional staffing to minimize impact on other city departments.

•Determine how Henderson compares to other similar-sized cities in the western United States in efforts to meet City Council goals, objectives and expectations.

City Manager Phil Speight said the study will help determine if staff is being allowed time to work with "an eye to the future" rather than pushing work through because the demand is so great. He said the most pressing need for the study is in the planning, building and public works departments.

The city's next step is to solicit request for proposals from various management consulting firms. A firm will be selected by the Council to conduct the audit in early 1996. The estimated cost for the study is between \$50,000 and \$120,000.

On Nov. 7, Alper sold Sky Harbor to Clark County for \$23.7 million. Alper said when the county approached him and made an offer to acquire the airport, he saw an opportunity to bring Sky Harbor into the next century and to continue his father's dream.

"Now that the valley is booming so much, the needs are tremendous. We just never had the dollars to develop the airport like we would like. The county is in the perfect position to do just that. I feel very comfortable with is in very good hands," Alper

"I have had plenty of opportunity to sell this airport out to a housing development. That is a ready market right now without question and I could have obtained a higher price. But I am hopelessly in love with aviation and I would like to see the airport continue for all time, and the county will do just that," Alper

Over the next 10 years, the county plans to improve and expand the airport to accommodate some of the general aviation

Alper said he plans to stay close by Sky Harbor and watch from a distance as the airport expands.

Alper said he and the Clark County Department of Aviation are still negotiating the fine points of the sale, but the airport is expected to change hands officially in January 1996.

Lovers of conflict, we are: Thanks to Edie Barker, director of the Henderson Senior Center, for coming in with an interesting column out of the Washington Post about journalism and conflict.

The column called attention to a piece of legislation overwhelmingly approved by Congress that had no inherent drama, no telling quotes, no controversy. It was just good legislation, and so it did not merit a lot of news media attention.

That's unfortunate and may be one reason why the public loses confidence in its political figures. All the public frequently hears about is conflict and gridlock.

Part of what defines news is what's new. A plane landing safely is not news. A bill sailing through the legislative process is not news. But a budget negotiation that leads to a partial shutdown of the federal government is

National news media devoted a lot of attention to Colin Powell for the last several months for this reason. Many journalists wanted a Powell candidacy, not because he would be the best man for the job, but because he would have made the race more interesting.

It's times like this that I enjoy working

for a community newspaper. We are not sensational. We certainly cover conflict, but we don't glorify it. We pride ourselves on devoting space to the mundane as well as the controversial items that come up at Henderson City Hall.

Language check at City Council: A man who was the subject of some controversy earlier this fall uttered an obscenity in the heat of the moment on public record at a recent City Council meeting. It was a wonderful quote, but we changed the offending word to "erroneous." We put the word in brackets to indicate to readers we paraphrased that portion of the quote.

All residents, applicants, attorneys, city officials and Council members should make an effort to watch their language and keep public discourse on a higher

# Binegar penalty phase: mistrial

A Henderson man convicted of first-degree murder for strangling his 24-year-old wife will have a panel of three judges determine whether he receives the death penalty or life with or without the possibility of parole.

Las Vegas District Court Judge Lee Gates on Friday declared a mistrial in the penalty phase of Mark Binegar's trial after jurors were deadlocked following a day of deliberations.

The same jury two weeks ago convicted Binegar in the Nov. 18, 1993, death of his wife, Christine Binegar.

Binegar alleged that during the couple's use of erotic strangulation sex, he strangled his passion, after she threatened to of parole," Binegar told jurors. "I

The Nevada Supreme Court will appoint the panel of judges, which normally includes the judge who presided over the original trial. A new penalty phase is expected to start some time after the first of the year.

A spokesperson for the Las Vegas District Courts said a trial conducted before a panel of three judges is similar to one conducted before a jury, with each side calling on several witnesses.

# Nevada architects honor local firm



# **Gourmet coffee** roaster moves to Henderson

The aroma permeating the interior of Sweeney's Gourmet Coffee Roasters' new headquarters could turn a teetotaler into a coffee consumer. Even if you are not a regular coffee drinker, I defy you to enter the business and not, at the least, consider becoming one.

The first gourmet coffee roasters in Nevada when it opened on East Desert Inn Road in May 1979, Sweeney's recently changed not only locations but their entire operation.

Bob and Marguerite Sweeney have a distinct advantage over the proliferation of new coffee shops that have sprung up all over the Valley-their 16-year reputation with local residents and businesses.

The disadvantage is that, today, many longtime, loyal customers don't know where to find them.

Here's the scoop: Due to the growing demand by restaurants for fresh-roasted and ground coffee, they ran out of room in their east and west side retail

stores. In August, after closing the two shops, the business moved to a much larger space in a commercial area of Henderson.

You have to be a bloodhound to find them, but it's worth the

Bob Sweeney is a pioneer in what has become a national phenomenon—the coffee business. More than 40 years ago, he worked as a coffee buyer and taster at the Boyd Coffee Co. in Portland, Ore.

He moved to San Francisco in 1955 where he again worked as a coffee taster as well as a quality control manager, for the Folger's Coffee Co.

In 1957, he was back in Portland as a plant manager for Folger's. When Proctor and Gamble purchased the company in 1963, he became plant manager for MJB Coffee.

After 17 years with MGB he decided to move to Nevada and open his own business.

His wife, Marguerite, was associated with Field Enterprises, Inc., and was a counselor with the Oregon State Employment

Together, their combined business experience has turned the Nevada venture into a landmark operation. Sweeney's is now ranked among the top gourmet coffee stores in the U.S.







# First phase of Seven Hills sold

Eight of 10 neighorhoods in the first phase of Seven Hills master-planned community have been sold to quality builders, said Mitch Stallard, director of sales and marketing.





# Tax breaks for home-based business owners

Operating a home-based business may entitle you to special tax breaks that can help maximize your income and offset some of the day-to-day expenses of maintaining your home and

According to the Nevada Society of CPAs, if your home-based business meets certain guidelines, you may be able to deduct business expenses for your car, personal equipment, and entertainment, as well as a portion of mortgage interest, property taxes, utilities, and other costs associated with homeownership.

Unlike employee business expenses subject to 2% of adjusted gross income limitation, you can deduct qualified homebased business expenses in full on your individual income tax

But before you start dreaming of tax write-offs, you'll need to be sure your home-based business qualifies.

#### Business or hobby?

Your challenge is to distinguish your business from a hobby. Generally, a home-based business is entered into with the primary intent to make a profit, while a hobby is pursued without the intention to make a profit although your hobby may incidentally produce income.

In general, an activity is presumed not to be a hobby if profits

result in three or more of the five consecutive tax years ending in the current year, unless the Internal Revenue Service proves otherwise.

Business expenses must be "ordinary" and "necessary" to qualify as deductions. An "ordinary" expense is one that is common and usual for your type of business, trade, or profession, while a "necessary" expense is defined as "appropriate" or "helpful" for your particular

#### Automobile expenses

If you use your automobile in connection with your home-based business, you may claim a deduction equal to 30 cents per mile plus the business portion of parking, fees, and tolls, or write off the actual costs of operating your automobile in connection with your business.

These costs include gas, oil, tolls, parking, depreciation, and maintenance expenses. Keep in mind that if you lease a car for business purposes, you must use the actual-cost method.

#### **Equipment costs**

The tax law allows a business to deduct up to \$17,500 in qualifying property in the year the property is placed in service, rather than depreciating the cost over a period of years.

If you are in need of some new equipment, consider the benefits of immediate expensing. Be aware, however, that the expensing deduction is phased out once the cost of the property placed in service during the year exceeds \$200,000.

In some cases, home-based business owners find it more costeffective to lease a business asset.

If the leased asset is used strictly for business purposes, you generally can deduct the entire leasing expense. When the asset is used for both business and personal use, only the portion attributable to business use is deductible.

#### Keep track of meal and entertainment expenses

You can deduct 50% of the cost of business-related meal and entertainment expenses incurred in entertaining a client, customer, or employee.

To qualify, a bona fide business discussion must take place immediately before, during, or immediately after the meal or entertainment. Also, your records of business meals and entertainment must reflect the amount, time, place, and business purpose of the expense, as well as your business relationship with the person entertained.

Look into the home office deduction

You may qualify to deduct the costs of operating and maintaining the portion of the home you use for business only if your home office is used regularly and exclusively as 1) your principal place of business or 2) a place where you routinely meet customers, clients, or patients.

You will not meet the exclusive-use test if the business portion of your residence is not used solely for the purpose of carrying on your trade or business. To claim these deductions, you must file Form 8829, Expenses for Business Use of Your Home.

#### You're in charge

When you operate a homebased business, you take on a number of other financial responsibilities, such as paying estimated taxes, insuring your business, and creating retirement savings plans.

For this reason, you may want to seek professional advice from a CPA with small business experience.



It felt kind of strange. Once [Ciprioni] made those birdies and I made the bogeys, I knew I had to turn it on.'

And turn it on he did.

"It felt good to finish like that," Nygard said of his birdie streak. "Now, I kind of feel I need to contend in all the amateurs. Now that I've won, I have to be a contender more often."

For now, it's time to concentrate on finishing his high school career.

"I want to play well in high school this year," Nygard said. "I want to win state again, that's a goal I have, but I want to play well and be ready to qualify at UNLV."

Nygard said signing early to play at UNLV helped his tournament play last weekend. "I got the college thing out of the way and just went for it," he said. "I was a little more relaxed."

He's looking forward to his senior year at Green Valley, but he's also looking ahead to his time at UNLV.

A trio of Green Valley High School senior baseball players and honor students recently took important steps in continuing their playing careers by signing letters-of-intent to attend major universities.

In the past two weeks, Gator outfielder Nick Day signed to play for Stanford while pitcher Taylor Myers inked with Arizona State and pitcher Cory Frey agreed to play for the University of California at Berkeley. All three players will receive scholarships.

"It shows a lot about [Green Valley] coach [Roger] Fairless,'

said Frey about the trio of Gators signing early to play at top Division I schools. "The way we were coached and all the hard work paid off."

Day said committing to colleges early in the year should help all three players during their senior seasons.

"It definitely takes a lot of pressure off so you can concentrate on the season more and not have colleges calling you every day," Day said.

Myers agreed that signing early is a bonus.

"That takes off the pressure and lets you focus on what you need to do now," Myers said. Last season, all three Gators

played intricate parts in helping Green Valley to its third straight state championship.

As the Gator centerfielder last season, Day hit .389 with 10 homers, 13 doubles, 56 runs scored and 53 RBI in just 35 games. Day said he couldn't be happier about signing with Stanford.

"I think it's the best place to go," said Day about the tradition rich Cardinal baseball program. "They have a great baseball program - they're in the College World Series every year — and it's a top educational school."

Day, who carries a 3.8 gradepoint average at Green Valley, said the distinguished educational level of Stanford is what I baseball," said Myers, who is made him choose to play for the Cardinal. He was also offered a full-ride by the University of Miami as well as being talked to by BYU and ASU.

"The opportunity to have [a Stanford degree is what did it." Day said. Myers, who many considered

the Gators' top hurler a year ago, finished 4-3 on the year with a 2.22 earned-run average while striking out 66 batters in 56 2/3 innings.
