July 1, 1983 - December 31, 1983.

During the above time period, 127 working days, I presented 156 childrens' programs to various agencies, schools, pre-schools and story hours' at the library. Other activities that I initiated were:

Saturday Movies

Began a 2-3 year old story hour in July

Continued with the 4-5 years old story hour

Weekly News Releases of Activities

Bedtime Story Hour once a month (started in October)

Bi-monthly movies for Opportunity Village

Field trips to the library by elementary schools of Henderson (18 class

Started programs for parents by Extension Service during bedtime story hour

Cub Scouts using library for activities

Servicing all pre-schools in Henderson on a monthly basis with 45 minute programs

Invited to speak at the International Reading Assoc. meeting in Henderson

workshop for preschool teachers and other childrens librarians

Special movie days at Thanksgiving and Christmas breaks.

Christmas Party (109 children attended) great success
