GENERAL PURPOSE

To retain and improve the friendly relations existing between the community and the Sisters of St. Dominic of Rose de Lima Hospital.

To assure the constant betterment of hospital care to the people of this area.

PARTICULAR PURPOSE AND FUNCTION

- 1. To counsel the Hospital Administrator in matters concerning relationships between the Hospital and the community.
- 2. To provide counsel in the improvement of hospital services to the sick and injured.
- 3. Organized at the invitation of the Administrator of the Hospital; and responsible to the Governing Board thereof.
- 4. Acts, at all times, in close cooperation with the Administrator as representative of the Governing Board.
- 5. The Advisory Board is not established to serve as a fundraising committee; but will be consulted concerning financing problems.

RESPONSIBILITY OF BOARD MEMBERS

- Pledge of support for the good of the Hospital, according to his personal capacity. Support meaning advice and suggestions on particular matters based on personal experience in business or professional activity, so far as such advice is not contrary to professional or business ethics.
- 2. To provide liaison between the public and the Hospital. Each Board member shall be an ambassador of good public relations.
 - a. Bring to the attention of the Administrator any serious or repeated complaints which might come to their knowledge.
 - b. Discuss any basis in fact of such complaints; and, if necessary, suggest ways and means for remedial action.

RESPONSIBILITY OF THE HOSPITAL TO THE ADVISORY BOARD

- 1. The Administrator shall give sufficient information to the Advisory Board concerning the conditions of the Hospital, its activities, and related materials; such as:
 - a. The services rendered by the various departments of the Hospital, such as an annual activity report; i.e., admissions and discharges.
 - b. A review of all professional activities, and their effect on hospital care.
 - c. The summary of the periodic and annual financial report.
 - d. Announcements prior to any major changes in policies affecting patients, especially changes of daily charges for accommodations.
 - e. Announcements prior to any major change in policies or organization.
