PROCESSION AND POSITIONS

START Argentine Gouchos - (remain at the foot of the stage)

Crown Bearers for King & Queen

(Stand behind each throne on stage)

6 Pages - Form archway at the bottom of the stage

Lady in Waiting - Connie Skaza

(Holding Queen's bouquet - 1 doz red rosses)

(Goes on stage to stand at the Right of the Queens throne).

Queen - with cape - holding mask on stick followed by two Hostesses holding her cape train. Hostesses follow her to the steps of stage, release her train and stand at the foot of the stage.

Queen is seated holding her mask to her face.

King - with mask, sash and holding Septer.

(Seated on stage with mask and Septer.)

Pages go on stage in back of thrones (or in any other correct spot).

Past Presidents

(holding one red rose and wearing sash with year)

Past Chief of Staffs - (To be announced by Gus - year and names - see schedule #1 ).

Past Presidents and Doctors line up at foot of stage in order designated - (see schedule #2 and #3)

M.C. Opens Ceremonies -

Crown Bearers present crowns to Governor & Mrs. O'Callaghan

Governor crowns the Queen

(Crown Bearers takes her mask - Lady in Waiting cursey's and hands the Queen her bouquet.)

Mrs. O'Callaghan crowns the King

(Crown Bearers take his mask).

M.C. Announces "Mardi Gras Officially has Begun".

Argentine Gouchos Perform

After Gouchos performance - Lady in Waiting unfastens Queens cape and takes her bouquet.

Queen and King leave the stage to dance 2 or 3 turns -

Coupled Past Presidents and Chief of Staffs dance  
2 or 3 turns

M.C. asks the audience to join in -

Two Hostesses that held the Queen's train escort  
Governor & Mrs. O'Callaghan back to their table.

Pages and Crown Bearers leave the Stage.

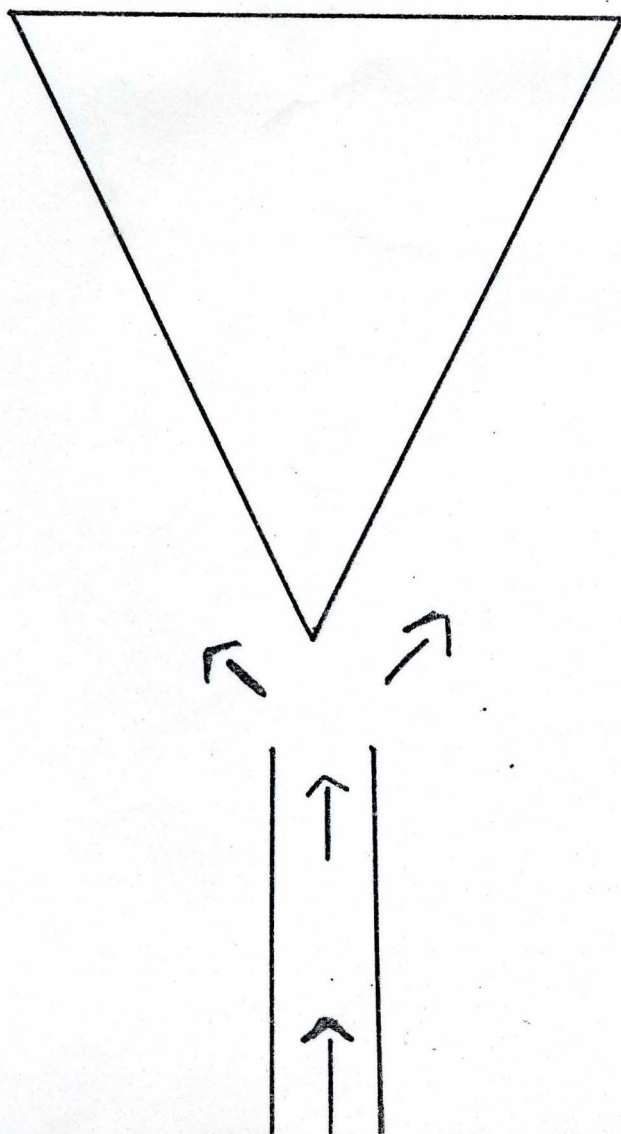

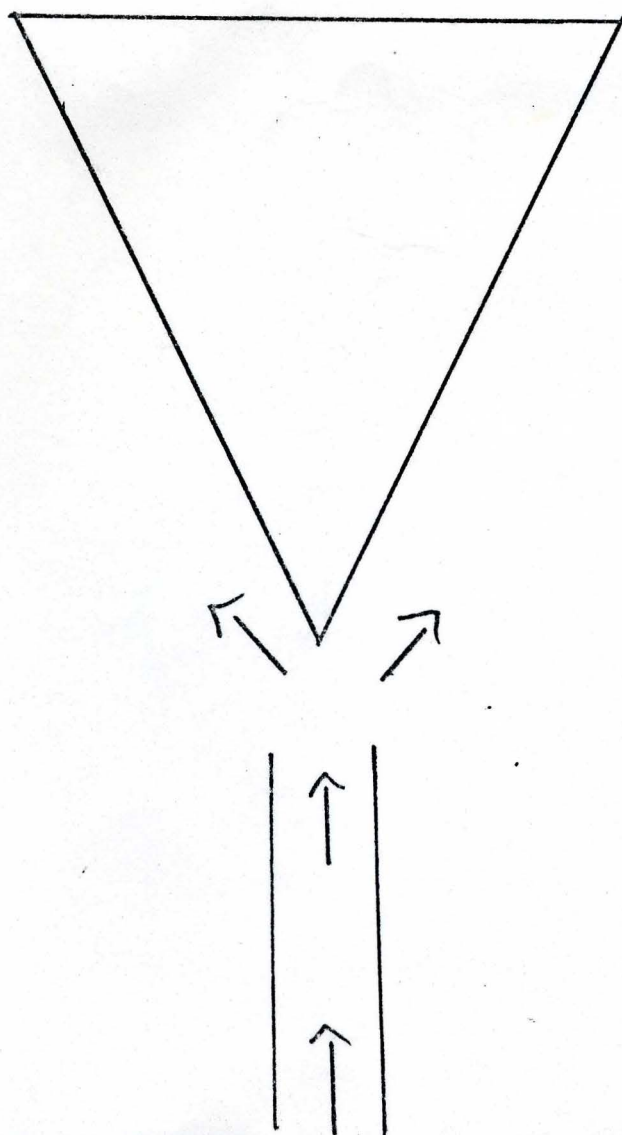
