

Anna Roberts Parks lived in Southern Nevada more than fifty years. She was one of the Las Vegas pioneers. She was born in Pennsylvania on July 2, 1888, and moved to Las Vegas about 1905 with her husband, William Roberts, the city's first mortician.

For many many years, Anna traveled over Southern Nevada with her husband; to Searchlight, Goldfield and Hoover Dam area, known as Boulder Dam area in those days. She had an eye to the museum value of organs, slot machines, stoves, lamps, dishes, wagons, wooden washing machines, indian artifacts, mining equipment, musical instruments, gemstones, furniture, china, silverware, gambling equipment, books, manuscripts, pictures, paintings, and other items that record vividly the history of this region, which within recent years has come to be the most populous and one of the most important areas of Nevada.

As the collection grew it soon became evident that her Las Vegas home wasn't large enough to house everything. People from as far away as Salt Lake City and Los Angeles came to view this collection and many Nevada pioneers contributed precious family relics. Finally, the collection was removed to a warehouse on 21st St. and East Charleston. A building 100 by 80 feet that was full to overflowing with the artifacts she had collected in moments of leisure, which were obviously a valuable part of the heritage of the area she had called home for half a century.

After her husband's death Anna opened Palm Mortuary, May 16, 1927 and shortly thereafter she married Gene Parks.

Anna knew she could not sell this collection out of Nevada even when similar collections were being sold from the area for as much as a million dollars. These collections were lost forever to Nevada.


Anna Parks steadfastly refused to follow this pattern. She worked to get a Clark County museum, without success. Curator fees, storage rent and insurance rates were too high for the collectors. So for years Anna kept her antiques intact, paying enormous insurance rates on the valuable pieces.

In 1962 when Anna was 74 years old, she died in an automobile accident and the collection was left to her only child, Edith, Mrs Weldon Jennings of Las Vegas.

Mrs. Jennings continued her mother's efforts to get a Clark County museum established, but local authorities were not interested. Mrs. Jennings then offered the collection to the Henderson Chamber of Commerce, if the Chamber of Commerce or some other organization could assume responsibility for maintaining and exhibiting the collection as a public



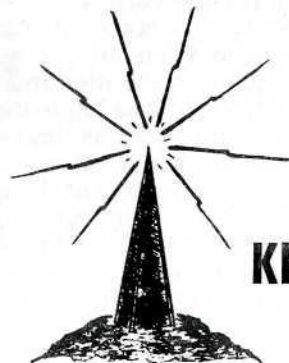

museum.

Recently the Clark County School District offered space in the old Townsite Elementary School gymnasium to house the collection.

The family accepted the offer and Young and Rue Company moved the collection to the Henderson site. Moving vans and a truck began the job of hauling the collection from the warehouse to the Henderson school building. Four van loads and four truck loads were transported.

President Glen Taylor said "Henderson is extremely proud to be the recipient of this valuable Anna Parks collection. You cannot put a price tag on relics such as these, but it's the start of a fabulous museum for Southern Nevada. We hope to have the museum open by Industrial Days and feel the school children will find it helpful in their studies."

"Of course," Taylor said, "it will be a long time before everything can be classified and catalogued, and even longer before all can be authenticated, and classified and catalogued, and even longer before all authenticated and restored. However, we feel this collection is valuable historically and educationally and should be seen as often as possible."

The Henderson Chamber of Commerce hopes to have everything on display by Industrial Days April 24-28 and work is going on daily to reach this goal.

FUTURE GOALS

Many other donors of Nevada artifacts have expressed their desire to exhibit their collections when this museum becomes open to the public.

Many people have given generously and unselfishly of their time and talents in the origin of this museum for Southern Nevada. Their skill, knowledge, hard work, and donations, all volunteer, is the reason the Henderson Chamber of Commerce is able to make the museum a reality. Many, many hours of labor and the generous contributions are what make a museum possible. Financial help may be forthcoming from any number of grants from various sources.

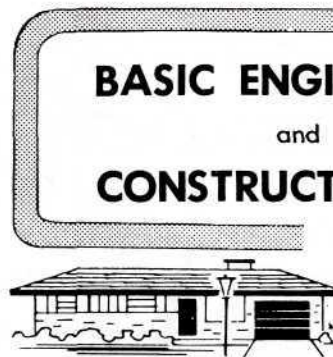

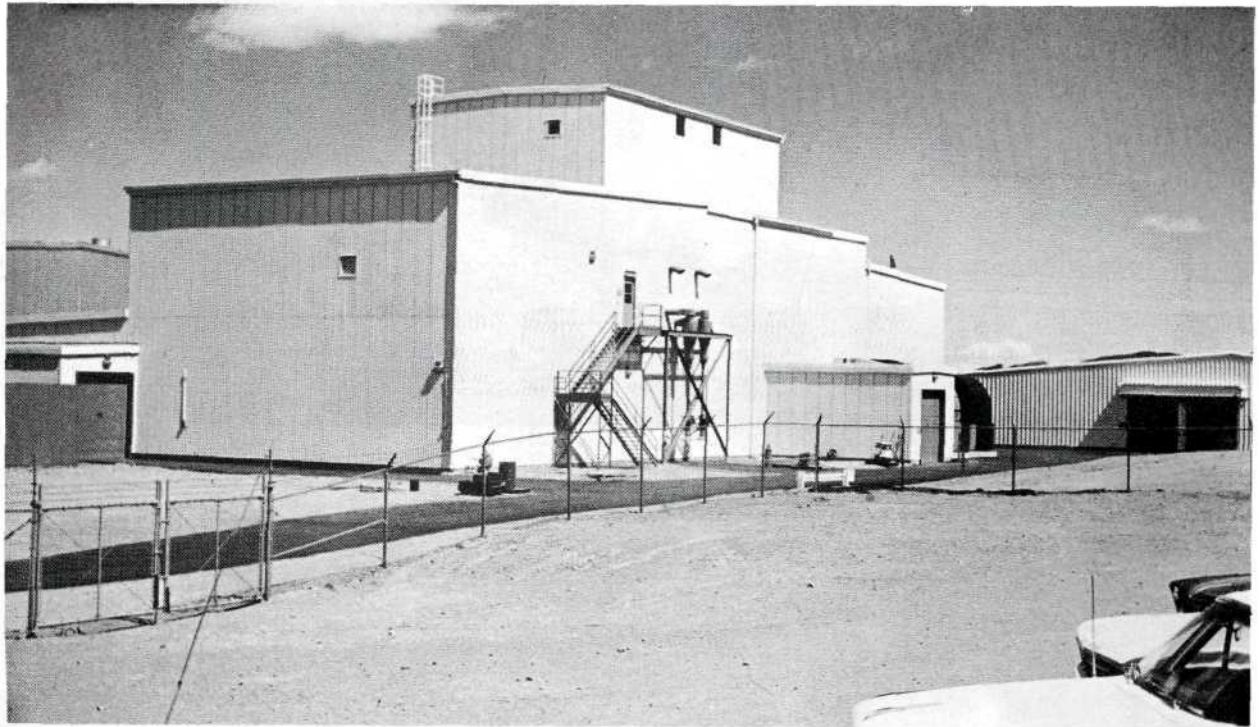

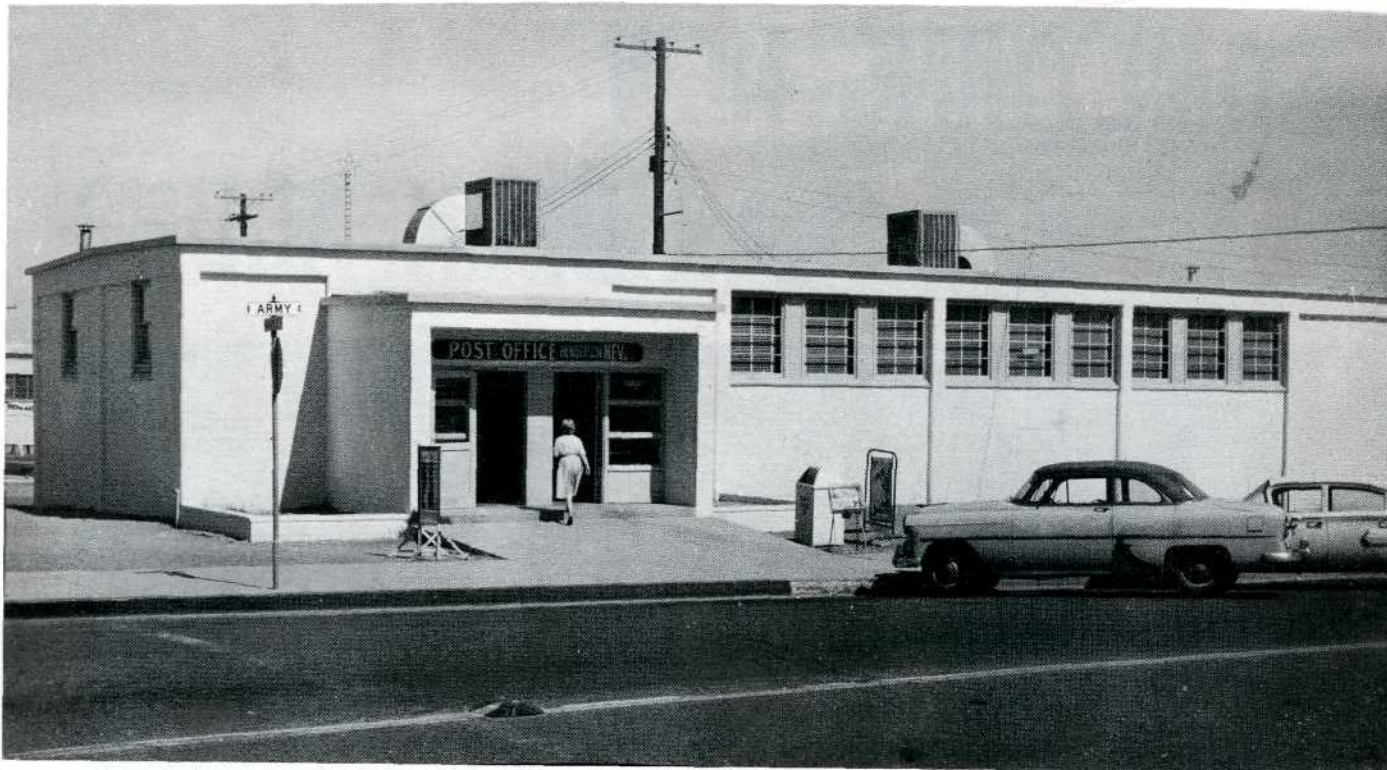
