

DR. CHARLES COPELAND SMITH

DURING THE FIRST WORLD WAR, DR. SMITH ESTABLISHED TEXTILE INDUSTRY ON THE ISLE OF MAN, OFF THE ENGLISH COAST, WHERE HE HAD CHARGE OF 30,000 GERMAN AND AUSTRIAN PRISONERS OF WAR.

COMING TO THIS COUNTRY IN 1919, HE BECAME AN AMERICAN CITIZEN AT THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE MOMENT. HE WAS A COLUMNIST FIRST FOR THE CHICAGO TRIBUNE AND LATER THE CHICAGO DAILY NEWS. HIS RADIO PROGRAM WAS WIDELY QUOTED.

IN RECENT YEARS DR. SMITH HAS DEVOTED HIS TIME AND ENERGIES TO NATION-WIDE TOURS AND APPEARANCES BEFORE INDUSTRIAL AUDIENCES, AND NATIONAL AND STATE CONVENTIONS. HE POSSESSES A KNOWLEDGE OF INDUSTRIAL PROBLEMS RIVALED BY FEW.
