SPECIAL FEATURES OF CONSTRUCTION

Basic Elementary School

1. The pre-stressed concrete roof slabs mark a new step forward in school building structural design. The floor, walls, roof, window sash, door frames and doors are 100% fire-proof being constructed entirely from the materials of concrete, steel, cinder block and glass. Only the shelves and wall partitions between the classrooms are of wood construction.
2. The Administration building and multi-purpose room, located in the center of the classroom area providing maximum efficiency of access.
3. All classroom individually, electrically heated and temperature controlled.
4. Refrigerated drinking fountains in all classrooms.
5. Utility water sink in every classroom.
6. Abundance of shelf and storage space in every classroom.
7. Classroom ceilings acoustically treated.
8. Spacious multi-purpose room equipped for cafeteria, music, dramatic and physical education activities.
9. Every classroom equipped with darkening shades for visual education.
10. Personal sanitation facilities designed to contribute to the child's maximum comfort and well being.
11. Well equipped pupils first-aid room.
12. Large kindergarten rooms with individual classroom rest-rooms.
13. Comfortably equipped teachers lounges for both men and women.
14. Large walk-in fireproof vault for safe storage of pupil and school permanent records.
