'WEATHER CAUSED LAYOFFS' - Mineral Company Explains

Wait on Weather

In order to squelch persistent rumors that his company would shortly resume hiring, Prescott Kay, of Mineral Materials Company announced yesterday that operations could not be resumed until weather conditions return to normal. At present there is 18 inches of snow at the quarry and even if work there could be resumed immediately, weather and road conditions between here and California would prohibit shipment of processed material.

Men who have been layed off, many since before Christmas, will be re-hired as soon as possible, Kay said, and there will be no need for hiring new employees for some time to come.

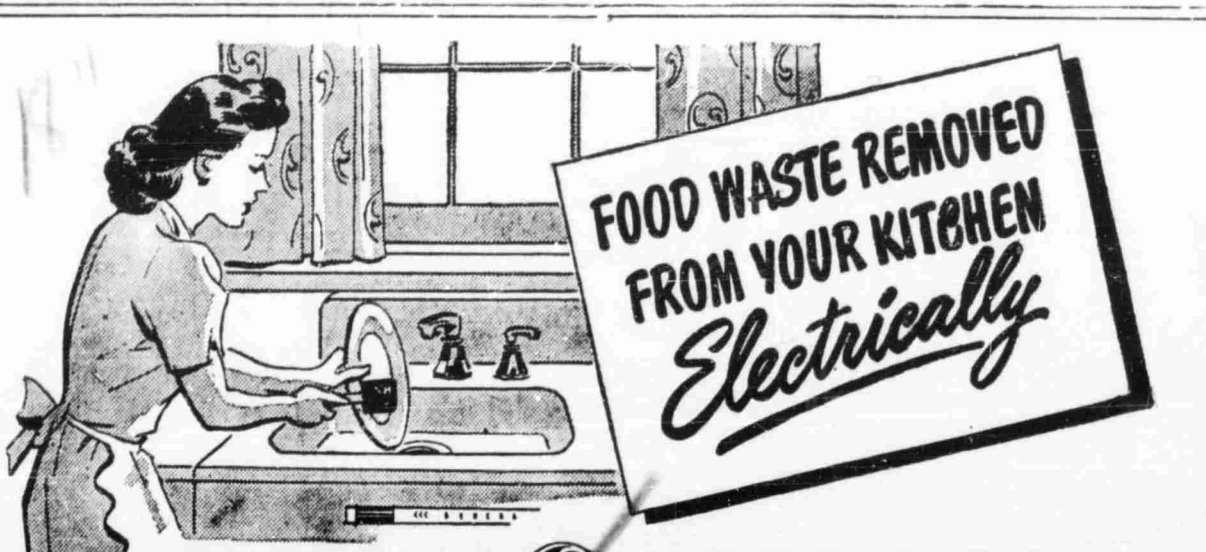

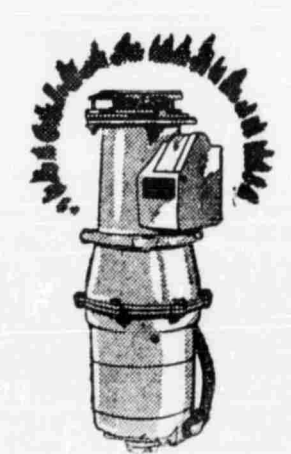

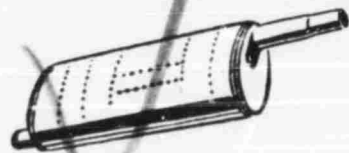
