Any member may be dropped from membership (1) Voluntarily, (2) By absence from three successive meetings and providing said memoer organization has been notified of absenteeism, and upon tailure to attend 4th meeting is automatically fropped, (3) By compulsion after proper notification, requiring vote of three-fourths of the Council upon written complaint preferred by any member provided that member in question has the opportunity to answer the charges.
