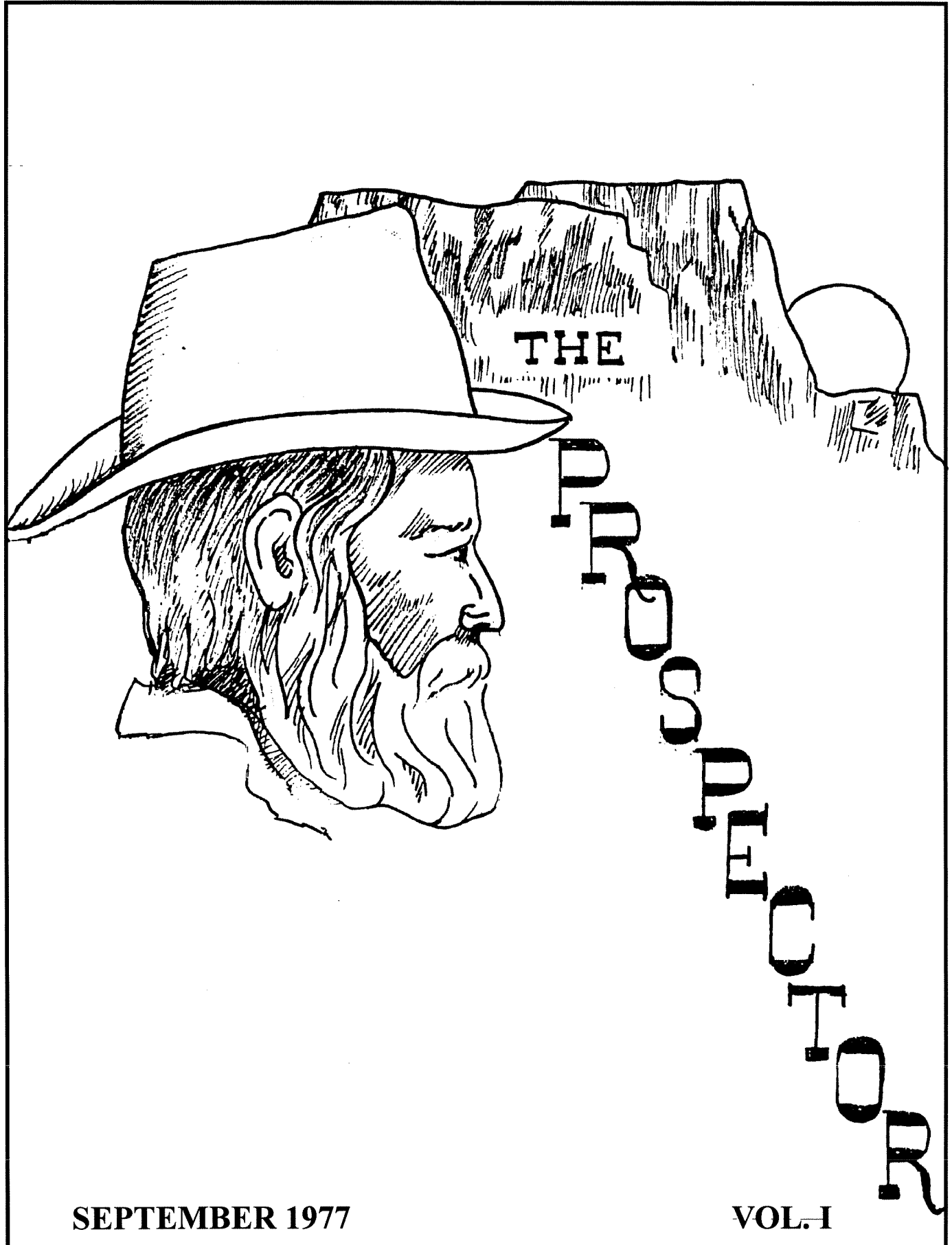

FAMILY RECORD OF EMMA ADELINE (KENNEDY) MAXWELL  
DESCENDANT OF ROBERT YOUNG

ROBERT YOUNG CAME TO THE UNITED STATES FROM IRELAND. HE HAD A SON, JAMES, WHO CAME WITH HIM. THIS SON JAMES HAD A SON, ROBERT, AND ROBERT HAD A DAUGHTER, ELIZABETH, WHO MARRIED HUGH KENNEDY. THEY HAD A SON, HUGH YOU (OFF PAGE) KENNEDY, JR., BORN IN ROCKINGHAM COUNTY, VIRGINIA, OCT. 20, 1822. HE MARRIED VIRGINIA ELLEN FULTON, OF AUGUSTA COUNTY, VIRGINIA, MARCH 17, 1848. SHE WAS BORN IN AUGUSTA COUNTY, VA. ON SEPT. 16, 1832. THEY MOVED TO OHIO IN NOV., 1865, AND HUGH YOUNG KENNEDY DIED THERE IN OCTOBER, 1866 AND IS BURIED IN MCKNIGHT CEMETERY NEAR SPRING VALLEY, GREEN COUNTY, OHIO. HIS WIFE, VIRGINIA ELLEN FULTON KENNEDY DIED MAY 25, 1911, IN CLEVELAND, TENNESSEE, AND IS BURIED IN FORT HILL CEMETERY AT CLEVELAND, TENNESSEE.

THEIR CHILDREN: HARVEY FULTON KENNEDY WAS BORN SEPT. 12, 1849 IN ROCKRIDGE COUNTY, VA. HE MARRIED BARBARA CATHERINE MILLER OCT. 12, 1870. SHE WAS BORN OCT. 1840 AND DIED JAN. 15, 1902. HE DIED IN MAY, 1904. BOTH ARE BURIED AT SINKS GROVE CEMETERY IN WEST VIRGINIA. THEY HAD SEVEN CHILDREN, 5 SONS AND 2 DAUGHTERS.

WILLIAM SMILEY KENNEDY WAS BORN MARCH 13, 1851, IN ROCKRIDGE COUNTY, VA. AND DIED IN 1922 AND IS BURIED IN STOCKTON, CALIF. HE NEVER MARRIED.

MARGARET ELLEN KENNEDY WAS BORN MARCH 28, 1853 IN ROCKRIDGE COUNTY, VA. SHE MARRIED JOHN FATTERSON IN 1871 IN AUGUSTA COUNTY, VA. SHE DIED IN JAN. 1883 AND IS BURIED NEAR GAULT, MISSOURI. THEY HAD A SON AND DAUGHTER, BOTH NOW DEAD.

ANDREW CYRUS KENNEDY WAS BORN AUGUST 14, 1855 IN AUGUSTA COUNTY, VA.—MARRIED ROSA YOUNG IN PORTERSVILLE, CALIF. FEB. 28, 1896. SHE WAS BORN JAN. 15, 1871. ANDREW CYRUS KENNEDY DIES DEC. 6, 1924 AND IS BURIED IN PLANO, TULARE CO. CEMETERY, TULARE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA. HE IS SURVIVED BY HIS WIFE AND TWO CHILDREN, MRS., ROSA (YOUNG) KENNEDY; MRS. IVA (KENNEDY) RICHARDS AND ROLLIS ALVIN KENNEDY OF 211 NORTH 46TH. STREET, SEATTLE, WASHINGTON.

EMMA ADELINE KENNEDY WAS BORN MAY 3, 1858 IN AUGUSTA COUNTY, VA. SHE MARRIED JAMES F. MAXWELL SEPT. 5, 1878 IN BRADLEY COUNTY, (CLEVELAND) TENN. HE DIED FEB. 17, 1927, AND IS SURVIVED BY HIS WIFE AND FIVE CHILDREN, AS FOLLOWS: HIRAM HOUSTON, ANDREW KENNEDY, ETTA JAMES, MAMIE JANNUTH, ALL OF CLEVELAND, TENNESSEE, AND WILMA ELLEN (MAXWELL) CLOUSE, OF LOS ANGELES, CALIF.

## FAMILY RECORD OF EMMA ADELINE (KENNEDY) MAXWELL, CONTINUED:

RACHEL ANN KENNEDY WAS BORN MARCH 21, 1860 IN AUGUSTA COUNTY, VA. AND MARRIED ROBERT LOCKRIDGE IN ALDERSON, WEST VA. OCT., 1882. HE DIED IN JULY, 1914. SHE DIED IN MAY 22, 1925. BOTH ARE BURIED AT DELAUF, CALIF. THEY HAD TWO CHILDREN, BOTH LIVING: A. A. LOCKRIDGE, BOX 429, TURLOCK, CALIF.; MRS. F. S. WHEELER, 245 JEFFERSON STREET, BAKERSFIELD, CALIF.

ARCHABLANE ALEXANDER KENNEDY WAS BORN NOV. 28, 1862 IN AUGUSTA COUNTY, VA. HE DIED DEC. 15, 1862.

ELIZA JANE KENNEDY WAS BORN JAN. 25, 1864 IN AUGUSTA COUNTY, VA. SHE MARRIED HENRY MATLOCK AT VISALIA, CALIF. JULY 28, 1889. HE DIED IN 1924. SHE IS LIVING AT THE HOME FOR THE BLIND IN OAKLAND, CALIF. HER ADDRESS IS: MRS. ELIZA J. MATLOCK, 3601 TELEGRAPH AVE., OAKLAND, CALIF.

ANDY KENNEDY, MARRIED RACHEL McCRAY. THEY HAD THREE SONS, HUGH, DAVE AND JOE.

ANNIE KENNEDY MARRIED ROBERT YOUNG. THEY HAD SIX CHILDREN, ELIZABETH, ANDY, WILLIAM, JAMES, HARVEY AND PRESTON.

RACHEL KENNEDY MARRIED SIMEON DOSLER; THEY HAD ONE SON AND TWO DAUGHTERS JOHN VILL, MARY ANN AND ELIZA JANE.

PEGGY KENNEDY MARRIED WILLIAM SMILEY AND MOVED TO INDIANA BEFORE THE WAR. (HE WAS MY GRANDMOTHER FULTON'S BROTHER AND MARRIED MY FATHER'S SISTER.)

THOMAS YOUNG AND HUGH KENNEDY WERE DOUBLE COUSINS. EMMA ADELINE KENNEDY MAXWELL'S GRANDMOTHER KENNEDY WAS A YOUNG AND THOMAS YOUNG'S GRANDMOTHER WAS A KENNEDY.
