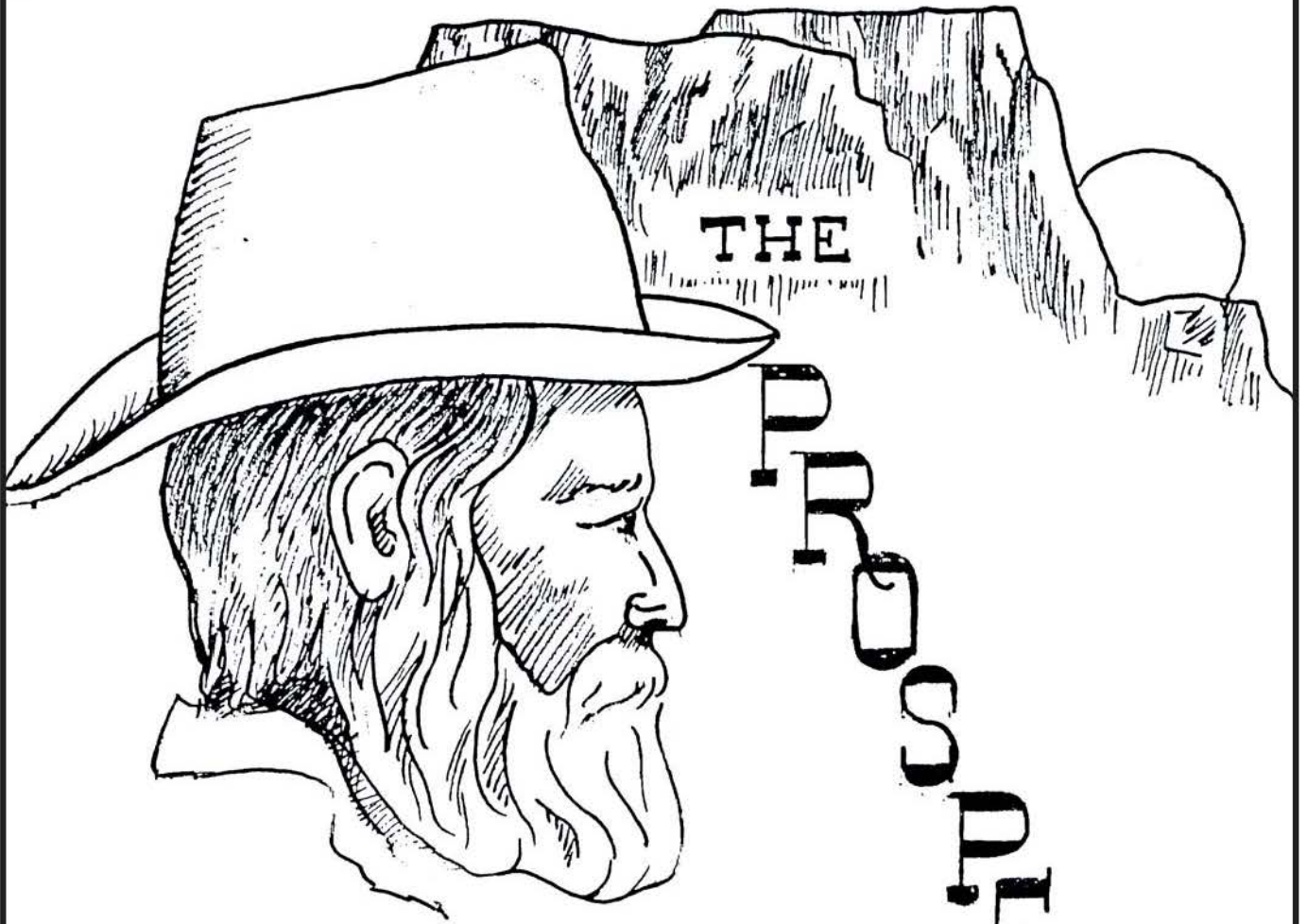

In the name of God amen: I John Poole being of perfect knowledge, and memory. hath ordained this my last will and testament revoking all other wills whatsoever; Item I give and benueath my soule to God, who made it and to Jesus Christ my Redeemer: Item I give and benueath my body to the earth, and there to be buried in Christian Buriall according as my Executor shall finde fitt. Item I give and Bequeath half my estete of movesbts and unimoveables, whatsoever unto my loving wife Sarah Poole to her, her heirs Executors adm and assignors forever Item I give and benueath my other- half of my estpte. moveables and unmoveables unto my well beloved sonne John Poole to him his heirs excecutors adm and assignes forever Item I give one of this my estste unto my lov'nz daughter Sarah poole one younc -nare- colt. This I ordaine to be my last will and testament, revoking all other Wills whatsoever as wittness my hand and seale this eight day of aprille, 1676
