





COPIES OF VETERANS RECORDS

We quoted in the July 1991 issue, an announcement from the Military Service Branch (NNMS), National Archives and Records Administration, that the cost of copies of military, passenger arrival, and Eastern Cherokee records is now \$10 for each record ordered and that new NATF Forms must be used.


The new forms allow you to pay by credit card; a very significant improvement. If you do not use a credit card, you are sent a notice that your record has been located, you send payment, then the record is sent to you. But if you use a credit card, the record is copied and sent immediately and your credit card is charged. This not only minimizes the Archives' handling of your request; it also gets records to you several weeks sooner.

NNMS evidently did not anticipate the level of demand for the new forms. Regardless of the number of copies of a form you request, initially you receive only one copy. If you need two copies, e.g., for both military service and pension records, you need to plan ahead! By the time this issue reaches you, the supply may have improved and the Archives may have enough to furnish the number of copies you request. Order copies of the new forms from: Reference Services Branch (NNIR), National Archives and Records Administration, 7th and Pennsylvania Aves., N.W., Washington, DC 20408.

PRISCILLA, PRISCILLA, ? ? ? ? ?

Having taught Genealogical classes for over twenty-five years and working at the Las Vegas Family History Center for a like period, so often I have found those searching for their family data are anxious to accept the first evidence that appears to indicate this piece of data may belong to their family. This is hard to resist. Nevertheless one must exercise good judgement in reviewing the data collected before saying, "yes, this is my family."

A number years ago when searching on my grandmother's line (Katherine George Smith), I developed data that seemed too good to be true, for it opened several collateral lines back for several generations. I was excited and could not write fast enough to keep up with my eyes or mind. I copied and copied and extracted data from here and there and built research work sheets that gave me what I wanted. I went to bed that night feeling just great, thinking, look what I've done. For years I've been trying to solve this problem, and here it is.

The next morning I began to study thoroughly all of the data I collected and little by little I could see that I had collected quite a bit of information, but was it of any real value in solving my problem? Was it what I wanted or was it an accumulation of information that may be related but may not be FACT? I was somewhat confused and really did not know what to think or do.

So I started all over again with my grandmother Katherine George Smith b. Dec. 1836 and worked back through each generation as follows: George Anthony Colby Smith b. 26 Oct. 1836, Caleb P. Smith b. 5 Oct. 1810, Moses Smith b. 17 Sept. 1778, John Smith b. 26 Nov. 1749. Now here was my problem. Who was the father of John Smith? Would you like to guess how many John Smith's there were in New England? For years I was up against a blank wall, making no progress at all.

I made a decision. I would embark on what I'd call my SMITH EXTRAC-TION PROGRAM. I'd collect SMITH data from ANY source and prepare Research Work Sheets and Pedigree Charts and isolate these from my other research work. After many months of work I came to the ROBERT SMITH (b. 1580) family and followed to forward to a SAMUEL SMITH b. 1714 who married a Priscilla Gould b. 1714.

Associated with this couple were names I seemed to be familiar with, like Elizabeth Curtis, Priscilla Perkins, Mary Pike, Rebecca Towne, Mary Duty, Sarah Baker, Thomas French, Mary Brown and many others I had come across in other research efforts. These same names also turned up in the early JOHN SMITH data I had worked on and also other lines.

I prepared a research work sheet for SAMUEL SMITH and PRISCILLA GOULD completing as much data as I could from any source. They were married 8 Oct. 1745 and had children subsequent years. However, there were also in the records children of a Samuel Smith and a Priscilla as early as 1735, 37, 39, 41, and 43. How could this be, for they were married in 1745? Next I found a Priscilla Gould Smith death record in 1744. How could this be if they were married in 1745?

After many, many months of sifting through data that just did not seem to go together I finally resolved the problem.

John Golde b. 1635 m. Sarah Baker and had a number of children. Among them were Zaccheus Gould b. 1672 and a brother Joseph Gould b. 1677.

Zaccheus Gould m. Elizabeth Curtis and had a daughter PRISCILLA GOULD b. 4 Aug. 1707 who died 25 Sept. 1744. This Priscilla m. 25 May 1734 SAMUEL SMITH b. 26 Jan 1714. This couple had children 1735, 37, 39, 41, and 43.

JOSEPH GOULD, Zaccheus's brother married PRISCILLA PERKINS and had a daughter PRISCILLA GOULD b. 6 April 1714. This makes her the cousin of the Priscilla Gould b 4 Aug. 1707.

After Priscilla Gould b. 1707 died in 1744 leaving a number of young children to be cared for, her husband Samuel Smith married her cousin who bore the same name: PRISCILLA GOULD b. 1714.

Well this ended roughly twenty years of research in an attempt to resolve this problem.

A review of the accompanying line of descent pedigree chart (page 5) clearly shows the problem and the solution.

What can one learn from this?

1. Don't be in a hurry to claim relationships not based on firm connected FACTS.

2. By all means do not force connections based on desire and not FACTS.

3. Work from both directions on a problem, i.e. from the earliest knowr date down toward you problem and from the current date back up to your problem date.


4. Don't be frustrated by volumes of data. Sift through it piece by piece. Evaluate it, discard data that obviously does not fit in with the solution to your problem. Set aside all data that may fit in with you problem for FURTHER EVALUATION.

5. Base all of your decisions relating to the problem on FACTS, not on maybe's, almost's, if's, it could be and so on. FACTS and FACTS only.

6. After you have resolved a problem and enjoyed a few days of excitement, go back, check each step, not once, but twice.

SYZDEK FAMILY REUNION

The third Syzdek Family Reunion was attended by Bruno and Phyllis Syzdek and son David, daughter Diane, son Steven with wife Vicki and daughter Beth, plus a friend Pete Onarato and son Gavin, all from Las Vegas, Nevada. The reunion was held in Bremond, Robertson County, Texas on 30 June 1991. Also attending were Captain Mark Syzdek and four children from McConnell AFB, Wichita, Kansas. His wife, Karen, did not attended due to a new addition to the family..Julianne.

This was another great occasion to meet many of the relatives. This reunion was more special because more of the family relatives were located, contacted and many came. More than 350 members signed the register from as far as Los Angeles, Ca., Chicago, Il., and Virginia.

The day started at 9 AM with registration at St. Mary's Catholic Church Parish Recreational Center. An 11:30 Mass at the Church was conducted and was followed by a covered-dish meal, program, awards, fellowship and dancing. Polish and other music was provided by members of the family until 6 PM.

A Genealogical Chart was displayed by the Bruno Syzdek family. It contained 742 names of descendents of Albert Syzdek, my grandfather, Marshal Syzdek, my Great Uncle and Anna Syzdek Zabawa, my Great Aunt. It showed their relationship and birth, marriage and death dates. They arrived from the Jaslo area of Galacia, Austria/Poland to settle in Galveston, Texas, and probably came through Bremen, Germany, and New York. Anna arrived in 1873 with her husband and four children and eventually settled in Bremond.

Albert arrived in 1885 with his wife and two sons; Marshal arrived in 1890, followed by his wife and two daughters. They all settled in the Bremond area. The town of Bremond was a railroad boom town with several churches, a post office, a school, stores including a drug store, and a resident physician when the first Polish settler, Joseph Bartula came in 1875. He made his home as a tenant farmer on the J. C. Roberts farm. After a period of mostly cotton and truck farming, Bremond, today, is growing due to the mining of lignites and to an electric power plant which is located practically on the farm where I was born. The population now stands at 1108 people.

We also have approximately 500 names and information on other Syzdek families in the United States and abroad and are working on their connection with the Bremond group.

Following a meeting of family group representatives, it was decided that the next reunion will be held on 26 June 1994; special projects to be worked on are collecting items for the family album, favorite recipes, genealogy and locating and marking grave locations.

Committees in charge of planning the next reunion consist of President Bruno Syzdek of Las Vegas, Nevada, Vice President Christine Syzdek Slominski of Bremond, Texas, and Secretary/Treasurer Joseph Syzdek of Philadelphia, Pa.

Many were remembered and missed due to illness and death but everyone enjoyed the fellowship, good food, entertainment and just getting to see each other even if it is only every three years.

Deaths Reported in the Las Vegas Age July 1, 1909 through May 31, 1911

On the two pages which follow, we present the second of a series of indexes from the pioneer Las Vegas newspaper, the Las Vegas Age, to be published in the CCNGS **Prospector**.

In the July 1991 issue, we published the list of deaths reported from the inaugural issue of the newspaper on April 7, 1905 through June 30, 1909. With this issue we continue with the index of deaths reported from July 1, 1909 through May 31, 1911.

ABBREVIATIONS


