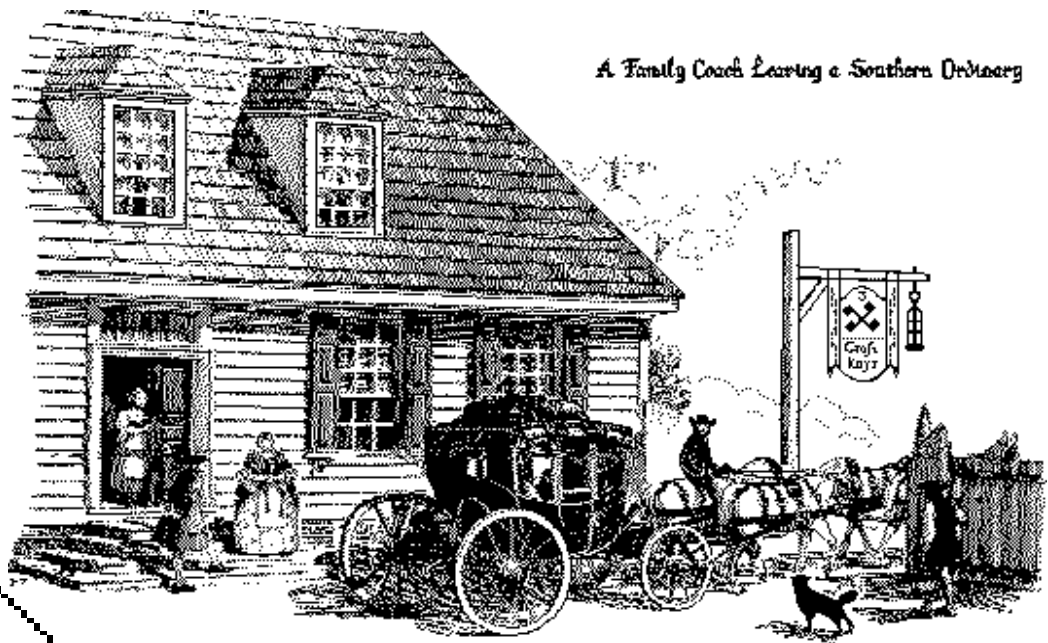

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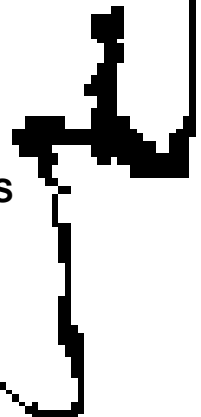

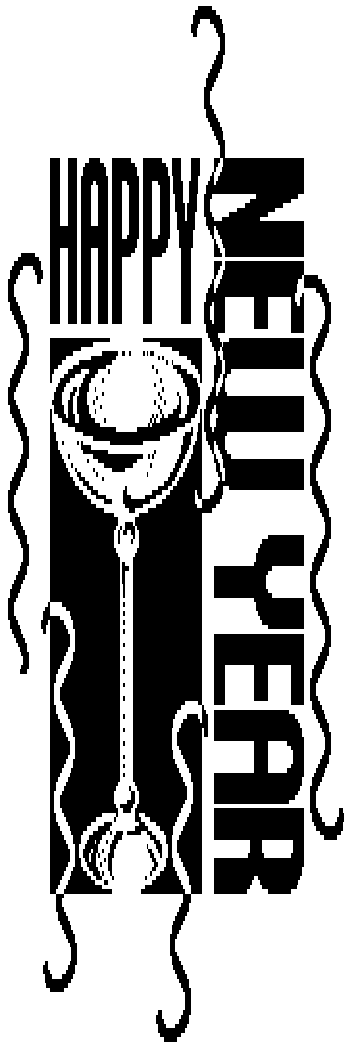

They research records of railroad workers if you tell them you are a family member. Send them the pertinent information you now have plus a SASE.

CENSUS RECORDS

Forty or more censuses were taken between the years 1600 and 1789 by the colonies and/or states. The first official census was done in 1790. Copies of these records through 1910 are available to you. (The 1974 Privacy Act prohibits releasing of federal records less than 75 years old.) You can request a census search for your family by writing to:

You will receive a form to fill out and return and for a small fee you can then obtain a copy of the information from your ancestor's records.

PUNCHING UP YOUR PAST

The Latter Day Saints Family History Library In Salt Lake City is invaluable to genealogy researchers. The Mormon Church, in keeping with its doctrine that non-Mormon ancestors should be "sealed" retroactively into the eternity of their families, has been photographing birth and marriage records from all over the world for over 50 years now.

The 150 million names reposing in the Church's International Genealogical Index can be tapped through a computer system that links 1,100 local Mormon centers in the U.S. and Canada with the repository in Salt Lake.

Anyone can walk into a family history center and do a search; the service is available for free. (You can find Mormon Centers in the Phone Book.)

The network allowed this writer to pull out birth and marriage dates on probable forebears who had emigrated from Ireland during the 1840s to work the silk and wool mills in Paterson, N.J.

Clues of that sort can be reinforced or discarded by correlation with millions of other documents - census and probate records, mortgage abstracts and tax lists - held on microfilm or microfiche.

The Church plans to computerize much more of this material. Because of the potential liability for invasion-of-privacy suits, the photographic records of the main genealogical index do not cover years later than 1910.

If you want to hire someone to do a search for you, be aware that there are a lot of scamsters around. Membership in the Association of Professional Genealogists is one good screen. This self-policing trade group provides an arbitration service for unhappy customers. For a roster of members and specialties, send \$2 and a self-addressed, stamped envelope to the APG, P.O. Box 11601, Salt Lake City, Utah 84147.

It's important to spell out the parameters of a search from the start. Do you really want to trace the family back to Ethelred the Unready, or is it enough to know where you come from in the old country? The meter can run up quickly. Hourly rates nationally run from under \$10 to as much as \$50.

RULES FOR RESERVING AND USING THE "FAMILY SEARCH" COMPUTERS AT THE FAMILY HISTORY CENTER IN LAS VEGAS

1. All reservations to use the "Family Search" computers must be made through a Family History Specialist. Patrons may not sign the logs themselves.
2. No patron will be allowed to sign up for two or more consecutive time slots on all "Family Search" computers.
3. The Specialist making the reservation will list the patron's name and phone number.
4. Tour groups may not reserve more than two computers for their tour.
5. All computers will be turned off at 6 pm on Monday and Saturday and at 9 pm on all other days.
6. Reservations will be held for 10 minutes past the time patrons have signed up for, then if the patron is not there the computer will be released for another's use.
7. If the patron has a large data file to download from the "Ancestral File" we recommend they start at the beginning of their time slot, thus allowing the full time slot for the operation. If pedigree is extremely large do not download to Gedcom more than 6 generations at a time. If needed, write down the name you wish to download information on and reserve an additional time slot later in the day to do the work.
8. CAUTION: Do not force the CD CADDIE into the CD DRIVE. If the caddie is inserted properly the drive will complete the insertion. The arrow side of the caddie is to go up to "top" of the G DRIVE.

These rules are made so that a maximum number of patrons may have access to the "Family Search" computers and is an attempt to be fair to all patrons.

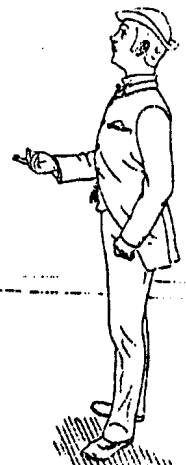

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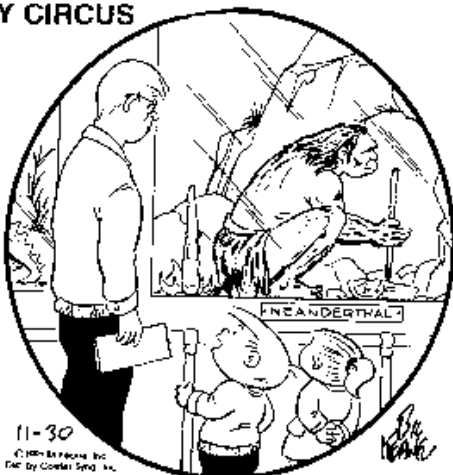

In this issue we continue with deaths reported from June 1, 1911 through September 30, 1913.

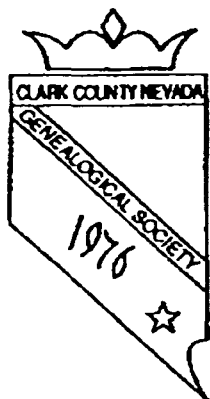
