

Barbara Bennett Social Security Information

I have worked for the Social Security Administration for the last 15 years. I worked in various local offices as a claims representative for 9 years, and have spent the last 6 years as a computer systems analyst at headquarters, 4 1/2 years of that in the Enumeration Systems Branch. I have put together information which will address the questions you have about getting information from the Social Security Administration for genealogical purposes. Although I am employed by SSA, I am doing this information as a private individual, not as a representative of the Social Security Administration. I hope they clear up a lot of the confusion about what is and isn't available and how to go about getting what is available.

DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION

Disclosure of information by SSA is governed mainly by the Social Security Act itself, the Freedom of Information Act of 1974, the Privacy Act of 1974, and the Tax Reform Act of 1976. In general, information about a LIVING person MAY NOT be released to a third party unless the individual has signed a written authorization for release of that information. The fact of an individual's death, date of death, and place of death or burial may be disclosed to anyone. Any other information, other than tax return information, in a DECEASED individual's record MAY BE DISCLOSED as long as any information in the record pertaining to other living individuals is deleted from the record prior to disclosure. The Tax Reform Act of 1976 prohibits disclosure of tax return information without the consent of the individual to whom the record pertains. This prohibition continues even after the death of an individual. Requests for tax return information for a deceased individual may be released to the legal representative of the estate; surviving relative (spouse, parent, child); or heir at law, next of kin, or beneficiary of the deceased. Proof of one of the listed relationships must be provided with the request for information.

HAPPY NEW YEAR'S RESOLUTIONS

It is that time of year again. The Holidays have concluded and we are entering a new year which means it is time to select some goals for the up coming year. Whether they are large goals or small goals, we need to decide to improve our lives in certain ways.

In our planning we can include our goals for our genealogical study. Some of the goals which we can attempt to achieve are listed below.

- 1. Commit 2 hours (or any number) on a selected day each week to genealogy; by selecting the time and day you are more likely to try to meet your goal just make it realistic.
- 2. Begin to organize your genealogical material so that you can find things when you need them; buy the files and use them; once organized continue to use your system even if it is not the world's best system.
- 3. Select one family or country to which you will concentrate your study in an attempt to solve some of the problems you have been experiencing and make it this year's project.
- **4.** Write one letter a week/month to relatives, libraries, etc. to acquire additional information; be sure to mail the letter once written.
- 5. Re-read the material which you have gathered and try to glean new information or leads which were not meaningful the last time you reviewed that information; sometimes we get information and never reread the documents which provide clues which were not evident previously.

- **6.** Go to your genealogical library on a regular basis; once a week/month; again try to select your day and time so that you will make it part of your regular schedule.
- 7. Attend your local genealogical society and BECOME INVOLVED; groups only function with members who become actively involved...it is not enough to belong, be ACTIVE!

You may find a great goal in this list or perhaps you have already thought of a goal which you need to accomplish to improve your genealogical study. Whatever it is, determine your goal and make a commitment to it and to YOURSELF.



Deaths Reported in the <u>Las Vegas Age</u> January 1, 1919 through December 31, 1920

This is the seventh in a series of death indexes from the pioneer Las Vegas newspaper, the <u>Las Vegas Age</u>. In the six preceding issues of the <u>CCNGS Prospector</u>, we published the list of deaths reported from the first edition of the Age on April 7, 1905 through December 31, 1918. In this issue we continue through December 31, 1920.

Influenza or pneumonia was reported as the cause of twelve of the eighty seven deaths in 1919 and 1920. All of the influenza and pneumonia deaths were reported in the first months of 1919 as the epidemic which caused forty three of the ninety two deaths reported in 1918 continued into the new year.




