

#### REQUEST FOR EXTRACTS OF PRIOR SSN APPLICATIONS

SSA originally maintained paper files of all applications for original SSN's and applications requesting a change in the record. In the 1970s, these files were converted to an electronic database. The application forms were microfilmed for retention and the paper forms destroyed. Current applications are microfilmed; the paper forms are retained in the Federal Records Center for 5 years and then destroyed.

There are 2 types of SSN application extracts which can be furnished upon request.

- (1) The Numident printout is a computer printed record which contains all the information on the original application form except the address and signature of the applicant.
- (2) A microprint is a print of the microfilmed application form. Either of these items may be furnished to anyone upon written request and confirmation of death where this is not detrimental to the estate and there does not appear to be an unwarranted invasion of privacy of a living person; i.e., the parents of the deceased who are listed on the application form. There is no charge for this service.

The microprint will not show the SSN assigned as a result of the application; thus, the requester will receive both a microprint and a Numident printout when a microprint is requested. TO REQUEST AN EXTRACT: call your local SSA office and request form SSA-L997 SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER RECORD THIRD PARTY REQUEST FOR EXTRACT OR PHOTOCOPY.

The form asks for identifying information as follows:

- 1) SSN, if known
- 2) full name of the person now used (or last used, for deceased ind)
- 3) name shown on last social security card
- 4) the individual's full name at birth
- 5) the individual's date of birth
- 6) the place of birth
- 7) sex
- 8) full maiden name of the mother
- 9) full name of the father

The form does not provide a place to indicate which type of extract you want, so enter the following legend on the form: "Microprint Required, Printout Not Sufficient". The form also does not include a place to indicate that you are requesting information on a deceased individual. I would annotate the form with a statement that the individual is deceased. Attach proof of death, if you can, to expedite

the request. Information about the death of an individual has not been maintained on the Social Security Number records, so your request may be delayed or denied if it is not obvious that the person is deceased. It will take from 4-8 weeks to receive a response to your request.

The 9 items above are the same information you would provide if you went to apply for a social security number or a replacement card. Here's how the SSN system works (much simplified) - there are 2 major files: the numerical identification file which contains the information sorted by SSN; and the alphabetical identification file which is sorted by name. If an SSN is provided, the numerical file will be queried and the printout compared to the information you provided. If an SSN is unknown, the name file must be queried. The information you provide is compared to the information for each person with that name and a score is assigned based on which information matches or doesn't match, and how closely the information matches. For example, if the year of birth is within 5 years it will score lower than an exact match but higher than if they were 10 years apart. Possible SSNs will be identified based on the score. Someone must look at all the printouts for the possible SSNs to determine which record if any is the one you requested. The more information you provide, the more chance you have of getting the information you want. After all, there have been about 320 million SSNs assigned since Social Security began in 1937. SSA assigns about 500,000 new numbers each month.

#### OLD MILITARY NEWSPAPERS

Military newspapers become "old news" to the average reader once the publication has been reviewed. But "old news" carries within it a small piece of history. That history is available to anyone.

The State Historical Society of Wisconsin is the self-proclaimed central depository for newspapers of the military services.

What began as a small bookcase in the Wisconsin governor's office in 1854 now consists of collections numbering more than 2.8 million printed and microform items on history, genealogy and related topics north of the Rio Grande.

#### LOCATING AN AIR FORCE RETIREE OR ACTIVE MEMBER

The Air Force may not release home or overseas duty addresses, but will forward a personal letter. Seal your letter in a stamped envelope, enter your return address (including your retired grade) and send your letter and addressee's name, grade and Social Security number or service number in another envelope to AFMPC/RMIQL, 550 C STREET WEST 48, RANDOLPH AFB TX 78150-4750. (If addressee's SSN/SN is not available, the locator needs his or her most recent Air Force base assignments/dates, etc., to help research an address.) Only one request per envelope. For a reply about the status of your letter, provide a stamped self-addressed envelope. Air Force locator service — free to retirees and their immediate families — is limited to one address per request.

#### Tartan - "The Myth, The Legend, The Lore And A Few Facts."

Tartan is from the French word "Tartaine" meaning a particular kind of French cloth of any color. The Gaelic word is "Breacan," whose root is "breac" meaning a "checkered" color. The checkered garment was a common form of dress by the Celtic people throughout\Europe. At the time of the Romans, Virgil mentions the checked garment in his "Aeneid."

The modern Tartan however, has its roots in the 7th century kingdom of Dalriada when these Scots from Ireland brought with them a shirt or "Leine croich," and mantle known as a "Brat." The brat was unlike anything worn in Europe at the time.

Any real reference to the national dress of Scotland does not take place until 1093, when the Norwegian "Saga of Magnus Barefoot, "tells of the King taking up the garb of the Hebridean Islands, wearing a short Kyrtles or tunic and upper garments. When Scots left on a crusade to the Holy lands they were recorded in France by Guibert of Nogent, in his "De Vita Sua" at the beginning of the 12th century. He wrote "You might see the Scots, fierce in their own country, unwarlike elsewhere, barelegged with their shaggy cloaks, a scrip hanging 'ex humeris', coming from their marshy homeland." The "scrip" is from a greek word meaning a container for a soldier's provisions. The first appearance of our "Sporan" no doubt.

By the 16th century the tartan was evolving in the Highlands and set them apart from the Lowlanders. Those south of the Grampians were considered "civilized," while their cousins to the north were "Wild." Running around in brightly colored garments with long hair, and no hose or shoes. By the end of the century the Scottish Soldier is set apart from his Irish cousin's, as he wore his belt outside their cloaks and over their loins. These cloaks were the forerunner of the "Plaide" which means blanket.

They became know first as the "feileadh-mor (big wrap), which evolved into the feileadh-beag (little kilt). The size of the garment varied somewhat but was about 5 X 14 to 16 feet. To put it on, the garment was folded lengthwise in a series of pleats on the ground. The individual then lay down on it parallel to the pleats, gather the material over him and belt it about the waist. The excess material hung down the back, or was gathered over the shoulder and in bad weather as a protection over the head.

District tartans seem to have made an appearance just before the 18th century. In 1703, Martin Martin in his "Description of the Western Isles of Scotland" writes:

"The Plaid wore only by men, is made of fine Wool, the Thread as fine as can be made of that kind; it consists of divers Colours, and there is a great deal of ingenuity required in sorting the Colours, so as to be agreeable to the nicest Fancy. For this reason the Women are of great pains, first to given an exact Pattern of the Plaid upon a piece of wood, having the number of every thread of the stripe upon it, .... Every Isle differs from each other in their Fancy of making Plaids, as to the Stripes in Breadth and Colours. This Humour is a different thro the main Land of the Highlands in-so-far that they who have seen those Places is able, at the first view of a Man's Plaid, to guess the Place of his Residence."

In 1746 at Culloden, not only did Prince Charles lose his chance to gain the British crown, but the Highlanders lost a way of life.



## UNDERSTANDING COMPUTER TERMS PART 1

BIOS - Basic Input Output Services. Software included with the PC that exists in ROM. Also called ROM-BIOS. The BIOS provides an interface with the hardware. BIOS is often revised with new hardware.

BOOT - The process of starting up the PC and loading DOS. Once DOS loads, the AUTOEXEC.BAT file, if there is one, runs. To reboot a PC, press the CTRL, ALT and DEL keys together.

**CENTRONICS** - Parallel connection. Used to refer to the parallel printer connector on the printer or cable.

CGA - Color Graphics Adapter. The card that plugs into a personal computer bus to give it graphics capability. Often used to mean both the adapter and monitor together.

**CONVENTIONAL MEMORY** - This is the standard of random-access memory (RAM).

CPU - Central Processing Unit. The micro-processor chip in a PC. IBM and compatible PCs have an Intel (or compatible) 8088, 20286, 80386, 80486, etc. Apple Macintosh PCs use a Motorola 68000 or 68030 microprocessor.

DB25 - A 25-pin connector.

**DEVICE DRIVER** - Software that is installed using the **DOS** config.sys file. This is usually a mouse driver or memory manager.


