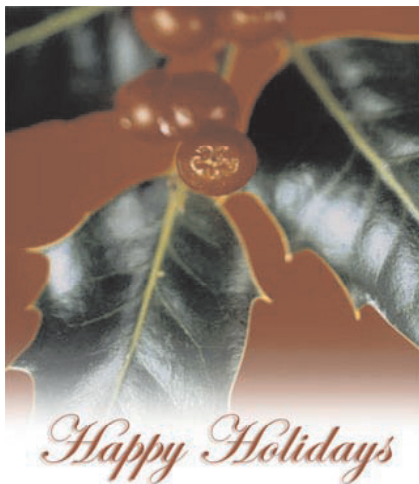

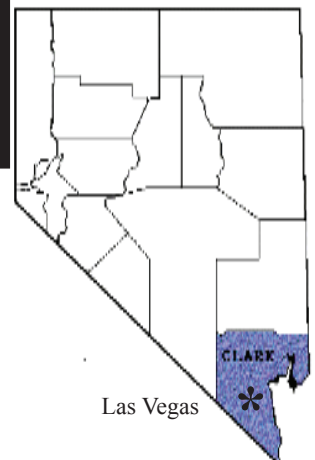

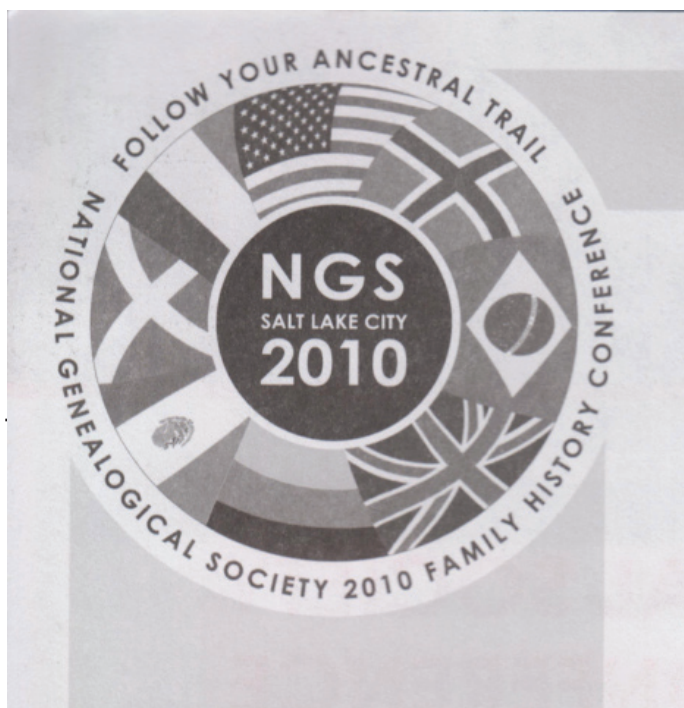

I once heard the expression, "May your troubles last as long as your New Year's Resolutions." I hope you are able to make and reach the goals you set at the start of this year. A few ways I have found to keep my New Year's Resolutions is to write them down; make small, measurable goals, and then share them with a friend or family member.

If you are a genealogist, here are a few resolutions you may want to put on your list for this year....

1. Start keeping a journal.
2. Interview a family member about his or her life.
3. Write names, dates, and places on the back of your photos.
4. Digitize your photos and share them online (also helps in case something happens to your hard copies).
5. Break down at least one brick wall.
6. Share your research with a family member or friend... or even with someone who is researching the same name.
7. Attend a genealogical conference. (Pre-register for the conference to take advantage of an early bird price.)
8. Join a genealogical society.
9. Convert your VHS tapes to DVD or CD.
10. Plan a road trip to visit a cemetery, court house, or relative.
11. Enroll in a genealogy course. Genealogy courses are available for beginners, experts, and everyone in between.
12. Become a certified genealogist.
13. Purchase a subscription to WorldVitalRecords.com.

Regardless of your goals, I hope you will set some, specifically in the genealogical area and make some progress. Happy New Year!

QUERY GUIDELINES

"Submit queries early and often"

The following guidelines for writing genealogical queries or posting queries to internet message boards may be helpful.

- 1. WHO:** Identify the person or a linking person you are looking for. Use the full name and include alternate spellings and spelling in a different language if known. e.g. John in English, Johann in German and Johannes in Latin. Include diacritical marks in names such as Bohn in English and Böhn in German.
- 2. WHAT:** What do you want to know. State exactly what it is that you are looking for. Are you looking for parents, children, siblings, ancestors, descendants, birth, death, marriage, location, etc.
- 3. WHEN:** Date and place them in time. Include as much information as possible for the reader to be able to identify the person(s) in the query. You may include their parents names and birth dates, burial dates, emigration/immigration dates, military service dates, graduation dates, baptism or other significant religious dates, names and birth dates of children, etc.
- 4. WHERE:** Identify an area where you know the person was living. Include as much information about locations as possible. You may include town, village, county, district and country of birth, marriage and death locations, addresses of residences over a the life of the individual, place of burial, name and location of schools attended, name and location of work places, name and location of marriage place, etc. Include diacritical marks in locations such as Tomazow in English and Tomazów in Polish. Use both English and foreign language spellings such as Rheinland-Pfalz in German and Rhine--

land-Palatinate in English or Bavaria in English and Bayern in German.

- 5.** All surnames in the heading and the body of the query should be in caps and bolded.
- 6.** All surnames contained in the title should be listed alphabetically, bolded and in caps in the heading.
- 7.** Names of all countries should be spelled out in their entirety except for the United States where USA is acceptable. USA is not needed if the query is for the United States only.
- 8.** Always include the names of counties if possible. The abbreviation Co. is acceptable but the spelling out of the word "County" is preferred.
- 9.** Using the standard U.S. postal system abbreviation for a state is acceptable. e.g. MA, PA, NV.
- 10.** Normal genealogical abbreviations are acceptable. e.g., **b.** for born; **d.** for death date; **bur.** for buried; **m.** for married, etc.
- 11.** Confine your query to one person or a married couple if possible.
- 12.** Always include how you are related to the individual(s) in the query and an easy way for you to be contacted (Email, address, phone, etc.).
- 13.** Keep copies and create a log of your queries indicating when and to whom they were sent.
- 14.** It is important to be as consistent as possible when writing queries.
- 15.** **Short concise queries** are more likely to be read.



THE NATIONAL WW I MUSEUM

The National World War I Museum at Liberty Memorial, which opened 2006 in Kansas City, is an invaluable stop to add to your information about your World War I ancestor.

The Liberty Memorial is a National Historic Landmark and the Museum has been designated by the U.S. Congress as the nation's official World War I museum. It actively seeks donations of World War I objects and documents.

The purpose of the Museum is to collect, preserve and interpret the physical objects of World War I. The approach to the Museum is a Walk of Honor, tributes by loved ones to those who had served in World War I.

The Liberty Memorial was dedicated in 1921 by President Calvin COOLRIDGE and completed in 1926. The memorial was restored in 2002 with major alterations and additions, the primary one being the National World War I Museum.

Archival information and a library in the museum's Research Center is open to the public. The curator can answer questions about an ancestor's unit. The curator is Mr. Doran CART, (816) 784-1930, dcart@

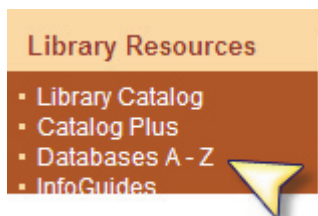

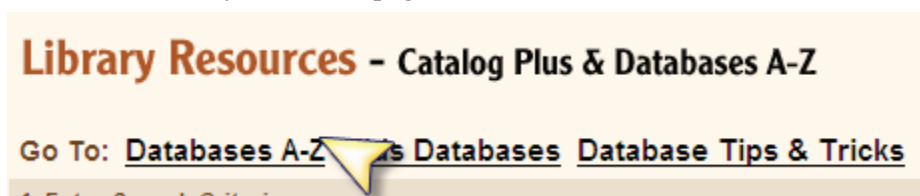
Access HeritageQuest Online Through the Las Vegas-Clark County library system

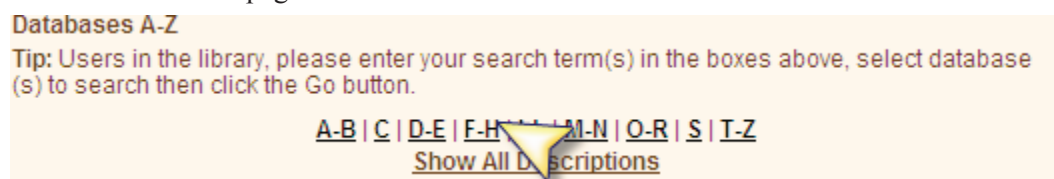
1. You must have a library card and pin number to access through the Web site, www.lvccld.org.

THE FAMILY HISTORY LIBRARY UPDATE



The Family History Library has around 2.5 million rolls of microfilm - The largest collection of genealogical sources anywhere in the world. A few years ago, FamilySearch announced their plans to digitize, index, and publish these records online. Paul NAUTA, FamilySearch public affairs manager, recently said that their goal is "to create a searchable world index."

In an article published by the *Deseret News*, NAUTA gave an update on the progress of the digitization efforts of the 2.5 million rolls of microfilm. He stated that "FamilySearch has 185 camera teams filming 60 million new images annually. Also, the Granite Vaults are having all of their microfilm (2.5 million rolls) digitized and that process could be completed as early as next year."

UPDATE ON CALIFORNIA'S AB 130

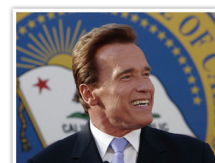


AB 130 by Assembly member Kevin JEFFRIES (R-Lake Elsinore) - **Vital records: marriage records.**

The section of the law relevant to genealogists:

"This bill would provide that nonconfidential marriage data files released to the public shall contain the name of each party to the marriage and date of the marriage, but shall not contain the maiden names of the parties' mothers. However, marriage data files for the purposes of law enforcement or preventing fraud shall include the mothers' maiden names."

This bill was signed by the governor.

OCTOBER 31st

October 31 isn't just Halloween, it's also Nevada Day.

Nevada voters approved a state constitution on September 14, 1864, and after a canvass, Territorial Governor James NYE mailed copies of the document to Washington, D.C.

However, it became clear the mail would not reach the nation's capital by the October 31st deadline, and President Abraham LINCOLN would not issue a statehood proclamation without reading Nevada's founding document. (RWE - how times have changed.)

So, on October 26, two telegraphers with the California Telegraph Co. sent the 16,543-word document from Carson City to Salt Lake City, a process that took 12 hours.

From Salt Lake City the constitution was telegraphed to Chicago and then to Philadelphia. Two days after the message began, Lincoln received the document at a cost of roughly \$4,300. (Doug McMURDO, "Pahrump Valley Times")
