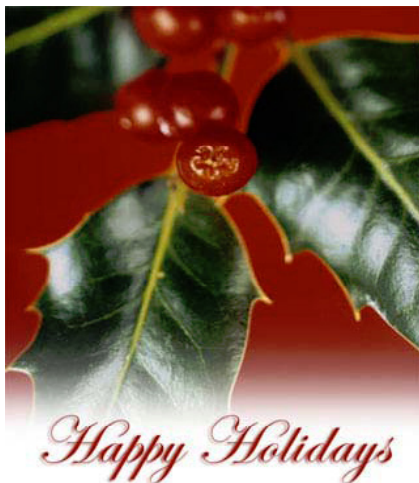

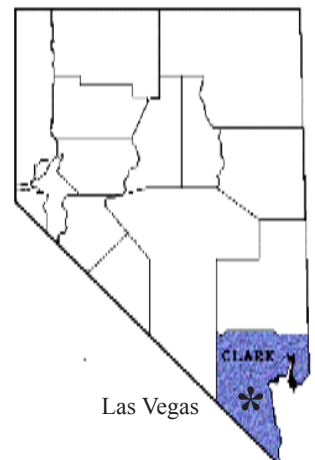

The year of 2011 brought some changes to the Society; changes that will help bring us into the 21st century electronically. We added a FaceBook Fan Page and, just recently, began a Twitter site. These are fun new programs to augment our two websites.

We continued the Beginning Genealogy classes at UNLV's Continuing Education and added the classes to their OLLI Educational Outreach program for even greater exposure. These classes have brought us some new members as well as spreading the word about CCNGS here in Clark County.

We will be teaching Beginning Genealogy again this year at Paseo Verde Library and increasing the number of classes to include both day and night dates. The number of attendees continues to grow indicating increased interest in Family Histories in this valley.

Apparently the downturn in the national economy affected attendance at our regular Fall Seminar which was down about 15% from previously. We repeated the venue at the Stan Fulton Building on the UNLV campus and included another delightful gourmet lunch but with an Italian theme.

Plans for the Spring Seminar next March 17th have been completed, featuring three prominent speakers; Kerry **BARTELS**, NARA archivist at Riverside, California, will lead off with a complete analysis of the '**1940 Census**' which will be released to the public in digital format in April. He will also outline NARA records that are now accessible on Ancestry.com and on Fold3, the new name for FootNote.

Kory **MEYERINK**, Manager at ProGenealogists in Salt Lake City, will show us '*What's New in Genealogy*' and explain '*Advanced Research Methods*'. Daniel S. **POFFENBERGER**, FHC's Senior Planning Strategist, will present '*FamilySearch 2012 and Beyond*'. He will also follow the luncheon with an entertaining presentation of the '*Lighter Side of Family History*'. Luncheon, of course, is included with your registration.

This Spring Seminar offers nationally known presenters with topics you indicated you want to hear. Tickets for the March 17th Spring Seminar are on sale now. Members of **CCNGS** have until February 18th to take advantage of the discounted price of only \$40. After that date the price of admission jumps to \$50. This one will be very popular and we are expecting our biggest crowd ever.

Have you seen the all new computers in the Heritage Room with those great easy-to-read keyboards?

You now have **FREE** access to Ancestry.com, Heritage Quest, New England Genealogy Society Archives, Newspaper Archives, World Vital Records, Digital Sanborn Maps, Find-A-Grave and many others sites.

Did you hear that the Family History Center in Salt Lake will ship copies of their film records to the Paseo Verde Library so you can research them in our Heritage Room on our readers? This is great for those of us who cannot make it to Salt Lake to do research. Our 'on-duty' member in the Heritage Room will help you with this. Check it out.

The Heritage Research Periodical Room (Heritage Archives) has been completely re-organized with all materials indexed by State and Society and now available in the Heritage Room for reference. Our Library staff of volunteers under the guidance of the Director, Sydney Cagle, did a remarkable job of bringing that facility into the 21st century and now it's so much easier locating exactly what you need for that missing piece to your family puzzle. There are many already published Family Histories available. Check them out to see if your surname is there.

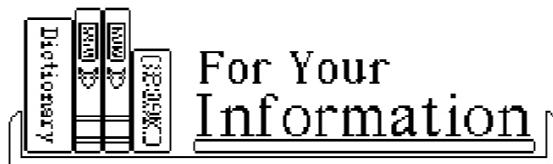

PENNSYLVANIA SENATE APPROVES BILL TO MAKE BIRTH AND DEATH CERTIFICATES OPEN RECORDS

Blake **STOUGH** has written an article in the *Preserving York* blog about "An Act amending the act of June 29, 1953 (P.L.304, No.66), known as the Vital Statistics Law of 1953, further providing for disclosure of records." In layman's terms, SB-361 will make birth certificates issued by Pennsylvania open records after 105 years, while death certificates issued in Pennsylvania would become open records after 50 years. This would open the door for these records to be available online to genealogists researching their Pennsylvania ancestry.

BOOK REVIEW

GERMAN-AMERICAN NAMES - Author - George F. **JONES**

After many years at looking at what seems to be thousands of names we may sometimes wonder what is the meaning of all these ancestral names. So it may be nice to take a break from expanding the family tree and find out what is the origin and meaning of the those surnames adopted by our forefathers so long ago.

The author has worked on compiling names for over thirty years and this is his third edition with over 15,000 names. This is a work of tireless devotion and the several revisions reflect input from readers and researchers that make this a very comprehensive reference book.

Of special note are the first four chapters that provide an almost magical insight into the life and times of our ancestors and how they acquired their names, our names now.

- Chapter 1. Given Names – Significance and Origin
- Chapter 2. Surnames – Their Need and Origin
- Chapter 3. Christian Names
- Chapter 4. The Americanization of German Names

We think we know how our surnames originated but the author provides much fascinating insight into this process that holds your interest with the background information provided.

The balance of book is easy browsing like a dictionary and who knows, you may discover some new surname meanings that you can share with the family.

HOW TO FIGURE A BIRTHDATE

Remember this number: 8870

This is the number to remember when you want to find the birth date of someone when you only have the date of death and age.

Suppose the person:

- d. May 6, 1889, at the age of 71 years, 7 months, 9 days.
 1. Write the year, month, day as: 18890506
 2. Subtract the age at death: 710709
 3. This gives the figure: 18179797
 4. Now subtract 8870
 5. The result is: 18170927

Year 1817, 9th month (Sep), 27th day, or 27 Sep 1817

Climbing over Brick Walls, One Brick at a time!

It was one of those days and I was in between errands with a spare 45 minutes and nothing scheduled. I was driving right past the library, so I decided it would be an opportune time to stop and see what I could discover. I slipped into the Heritage Room and, not having much of a plan, decided to "travel" to Nebraska and search for the graves of my husband's grandparent's: Paul and Wilhelmina **WEIBLE**.

At the library, I decided to go to one of my favorite sites, "**Find a Grave**", and typed in "Dalton, Nebraska". I visited the Nebraska cemeteries several times looking for Paul and Wilhelmina Barbara's burial place, but with no luck. I felt today would be different and that I would find them in one of the cemeteries in the Dalton area. Pulling up the list of internments again, I almost missed them, but there they were, Paul and Wilhelmina B, just waiting for me to find them. I was so excited! And there was a picture of their headstone, still in good condition.

As I was entering their information, I remembered I had seen a 3rd **WEIBLE** name: Margaret Leotia **WEIBLE**. No one in my husband's family had ever mentioned that name before and being more than a little curious, I went back to the graves with pictures but there was none for her. But she *was* listed in the cemetery. Who was this mystery person?

According to the location of the headstone, it was in close proximity to Paul and Wilhelmina, so she was most likely related. I found a copy of her inscription and discovered that this was their child; they had had a daughter, and no-one had ever known this. Furthermore, she was only 8 years old when she passed away in 1925, one week after her birthday (October 17, 1917 - October 28, 1925). My excitement changed to a feeling of sadness: this child had been forgotten; no one had ever mentioned her; no one had ever talked about her or about how the grandparents had lost a child. How could this have happened? How could this child be so forgotten? She would have been the big sister of the two children that had been adopted: Paul and Grace. How could it be that Paul had never mentioned her to his wife and/or children, even in passing? Did Grace ever mention her to her husband and child? Perhaps she did since she stayed in the same neighborhood where she grew up, but Grace died several years ago also, and no-one had any information on how to contact her and/or her family members.

I asked my husband when he got home that night why no one ever mentioned this little girl. He had no idea of whom I was talking about. He asked his sister and brothers; they had never heard of this child either. There is an elderly relative who lives in Texas who might know and we tasked my husband's older brother to contact him and ask "Who was this child?" and "How did she die?"

Meanwhile, I started scouring through records in Nebraska. Everywhere I looked, I came up with a dead end. No birth certificates, no death certificates, no baptismal or christening certificates, no obits. No school records. Nothing. No recorded natural disasters, no recorded disease running rampant through the town in 1925. It was as if Margaret never existed.

The next family gathering was a birthday party for one of the younger kids. The conversation turned to this newly found relative. My husband's oldest sister remembered that they had visited their grandparents farm when they were young and her grandmother (Wilhelmina Barbara) had given her a christening gown that she had made but had never used. Well, as far as she knew, "had never been used." We all mutually decided that it must have been Little Margaret's christening gown. We don't know if Little Margaret was born with

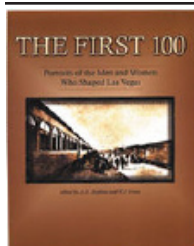
health problems or if she was exposed to a virus such as polio or small pox. Little Margaret has become one of my brick walls for my husband's family history.

But what do I know about Little Margaret's family? I know that her father, Paul **WEIBLE**, was born on April 21, 1886, in Nebraska. I don't know the actual birth place, but according to the 1900 Federal Census, on June 13, 1900, he and his family were living in the Belmont Precinct of Otoe County, Nebraska. He was 14 years old at the time. His parents were Jacob and Katie **WEIBLE**, both born in Germany. They had been married for 21 years and had a dozen children, all living at home: Jacob, Fred, Fresia, Paul, Katie, Adolph, Emma, Willie, Telia, Edia and Albert. All of the children were born in the United States, in Nebraska, possibly in Belmont Precinct? The 3 oldest sons, 19 year old Jacob, 17 year old Fred and 14 year old Paul were all working as farm hands on their father's farm; all of them were able to read, write and speak English. The younger children were listed in the census as students and the youngest children, those who were still toddlers and younger, were simply listed as children.

I know that Wilhelmina Barbara **KLUGHERZ**, Little Margaret's mother, was born on August 23, 1887, in Lafayette Precinct, Nemaha County, Nebraska. Wilhelmina Barbara had two brothers, Henry and Frederic, and two sisters, Lizzie and Katy. Wilhelmina died while living in Dalton, Cheyenne County, Nebraska. I know she was baptized in Johnson County, Nebraska at the Zion Lutheran Church on September 11, 1887, and she made her confirmation on May 6, 1900, at the same church. She died in August, 1973, and left a great portion of her money and property to the church and to the University. She is buried in Dalton Cemetery, Cheyenne County, Nebraska.

My husband, his brothers, and sisters always said that their grandparents were hard working farmers, owning their own farm and working it. They did not have any children of their own as they could not have any, and in 1928, they adopted two children, aged 2 years old, from "The Fitzsimmons House." After the adoption was completed, the boy was named "Paul **WEIBLE**, II" and the girl was named "Grace **WEIBLE**". Their birthdays were close: young Grace's birthday January 26, 1926, and young Paul's birthday was February 5, 1926. The family story is that both of these children were born in Omaha, Nebraska, but I've not been able to find birth certificates for them. I'm sure life was hard as farmer's children and I'm sure that both children had numerous chores to do around the farm. The girl, Grace, stayed in Nebraska, growing up on the farm, marrying Ervin H. **MARX** and had one daughter named Cheryl **MARX**. The boy, Paul, left home when he was about 14 years old to find his fortune. He married Edith D. **PIERCE** and fathered 6 children. Paul's family led a nomadic lifestyle, never staying long in one place and lived in Nebraska, California, Arizona and Nevada.

Since I've not had much luck in locating any information on Little Margaret, I decided that I will contact the genealogical society in Dalton, Nebraska to see if anyone there would be able to help climb my brick wall to answer the question: "Who are you Little Margaret?"

REGISTER ONLINE FOR CLASSES

Social Security Administration extends FOIA restriction to 100 years

Unfortunately, it's now official. I have been ordering Social Security applications for several decades and have found them especially valuable over the last decade for assisting with my Army cases. A few years ago, I noticed that they were starting to block out names of parents on the applications which is very unfortunate since that's the primary reason for ordering them. Still, the restriction seemed to pertain to applications for those born from 1940 or so on, and the explanation was that their parents could still be alive. So though I wasn't keen on it, I could understand the logic.

But recently without any announcement the Administration extended the restriction to 100 years that is, 100 years from the birth of the applicant. So now we can only obtain this record in an unaltered state for those born prior to 1912. This letter is in response to one I wrote to the Social Security Administration where I explained how it would negatively impact the ability to locate soldiers' family members and that the parents whose privacy was suddenly being protected would have to be somewhere on the order of 120 to 150 years old, if alive. I can apparently receive the full application if I can prove that the parents are deceased, but 1) that's a catch-22 since that's exactly why I usually ordered the document in the first place, and 2) many of my cases are for foreign-born soldiers who immigrated to the U.S., so I would have to seek death certificates from places ranging from Finland to the Philippines.

For similar reasons, this perplexingly long restriction will obviously also affect the 40% of Americans of Ellis Island heritage, which is also regrettable as this was the best tool for learning the names of the parents of immigrants so you could then extend your research overseas. I'm very disappointed in this decision and truly can't grasp what has caused the Administration to put such a severe restriction in place – far in excess of that of most states that have limits on death certificate access. I want let the genealogical community know of this new policy as it would be unfortunate for others to spend money needlessly. Because this policy was never announced, I have spent money on four requests (\$27 or \$29 each) for people born in the 19-teens, only to receive documents of no value to me. **You might want to let your friends in the genealogical community know of this policy change.**

2012 SPRING SEMINAR - 17 March 2012

Kerry **BARTELS** is an Archives Specialist at the National Archives at Riverside. A professional archivist since 1977, he has worked in historical societies, libraries, museums, universities, state archives, and now at the National Archives. A genealogist since 1962, he has done extensive research in the United States and Canada as well as many nations in Europe. 1) **1940 Census** - The 1940 Census will be released to the public in digital format on April 2, 2012. This session will first discuss the questions that were asked on the 1940 Census and how the enumerators compiled the information. Both of these areas will be examined from the perspective of their effect on genealogical research. The presentation will also cover online access to the census documentation and associated records and National Archives internet sites containing additional information about the census.

2) **NARA Records on Ancestry & FootNote (aka Fold3)** - Ancestry and Fold3 have partnered with the National Archives to digitize the holdings of the National Archives. The result has been an every increasing quantity of records of the U.S. government on both of these online services that are essential to genealogical research. This session is aimed at improving your results while using these services and explaining more about the Federal records you find on these services and how they fit together with Federal records that are not yet online.

Kory **MEYERINK**, MLS, AG, FUGA, Manager at ProGenealogists in Salt Lake City. Formerly with Ancestry and the Family History Library. Past President of UGA, founder of the Salt Lake Institute of Genealogy. Nationally known speaker, editor of Printed Sources, adjunct faculty for BYU and San Jose State University. 1) **What's New in Genealogy: New sources and Strategies for Successful Research** - All genealogists like to learn about new ways or sources that may solve their toughest problems. This lecture, regularly updated, identifies recent new sources, including reference tools, finding aids, new original and compiled records. It also discusses some often overlooked records and computerized sources. Uncommon strategies are described, such as historical and biographical research, use of bibliographies, periodicals and genealogical societies.

2) **An Overview of Advanced Research Methods** - For successful genealogical research, it is not enough to simply learn more about the sources we use, or to learn about additional sources. Advanced researchers use the same sources as all genealogists, they just use them differently! This overview of how to go beyond sources is intended to suggest ways in which experienced researchers can become better.

Daniel S. **POFFENBERGER** is a senior Strategy and Planning specialist and also spends time as a research consultant on the British Research desk for the Family History Library in Salt Lake City, Utah. He served a two-year LDS Mission in Port-au-Prince, Haiti and returned there in January, 2010 after the earthquake to translate for medical personnel. His genealogical research accreditation in English research has been active with ICAPGen since 2005, and he specializes in English, Scottish, Irish, US and Canadian research. He was elected as a commissioner of ICAPGen in 2008 and is currently the finance officer. (Research Assistance Project Manager. 1) **The Much, Extremely, Incredibly Lighter Side of Family History: Funny names and other fascinating finds from years of research** This is not a lecture per se but more of a comedic look at actual parish register, census and other genealogical records to demonstrate the humorous, interesting and, at times, almost painful aspects of our ancestor's lives. The actual records are shown and 95% date from the 19th century and before. My collection of funny names (Thankful Poop) and curious entries (did the bicycle really chase and kick his rider while he was down?) will be presented.

2) **FamilySearch 2012 and Beyond (2010 & 2011 also)** - FamilySearch currently has a variety of websites available: www.familysearch.org, <http://indexing.familysearch.org>, <http://wiki.familysearch.org>, <http://labs.familysearch.org>, <http://new.familysearch.org>, and <http://maps.familysearch.org> to name a few. This lecture will take you through the important parts of each, including recent updates and changes then describe the direction FamilySearch is going including the vision of combining the sites and information on them in the future.
